This week the tennis team had a difficult schedule facing dual meets with Highland Park and Deerfield and traveling three hours to Moline for their Invitational Tournament.

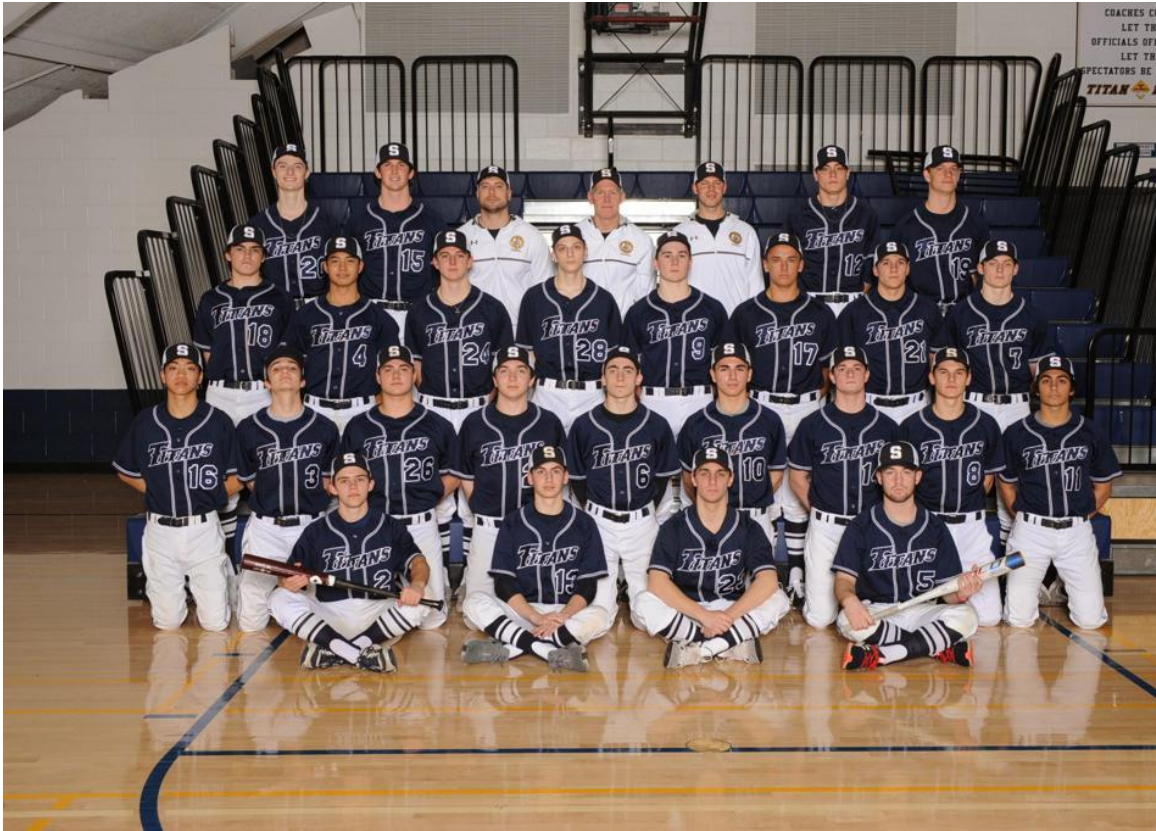
The tennis team was disappointed losing both dual meets by very close scores of 4-3. The team had opportunities to win both meets but were unable to win a critical match in each meet.

Sailing Club

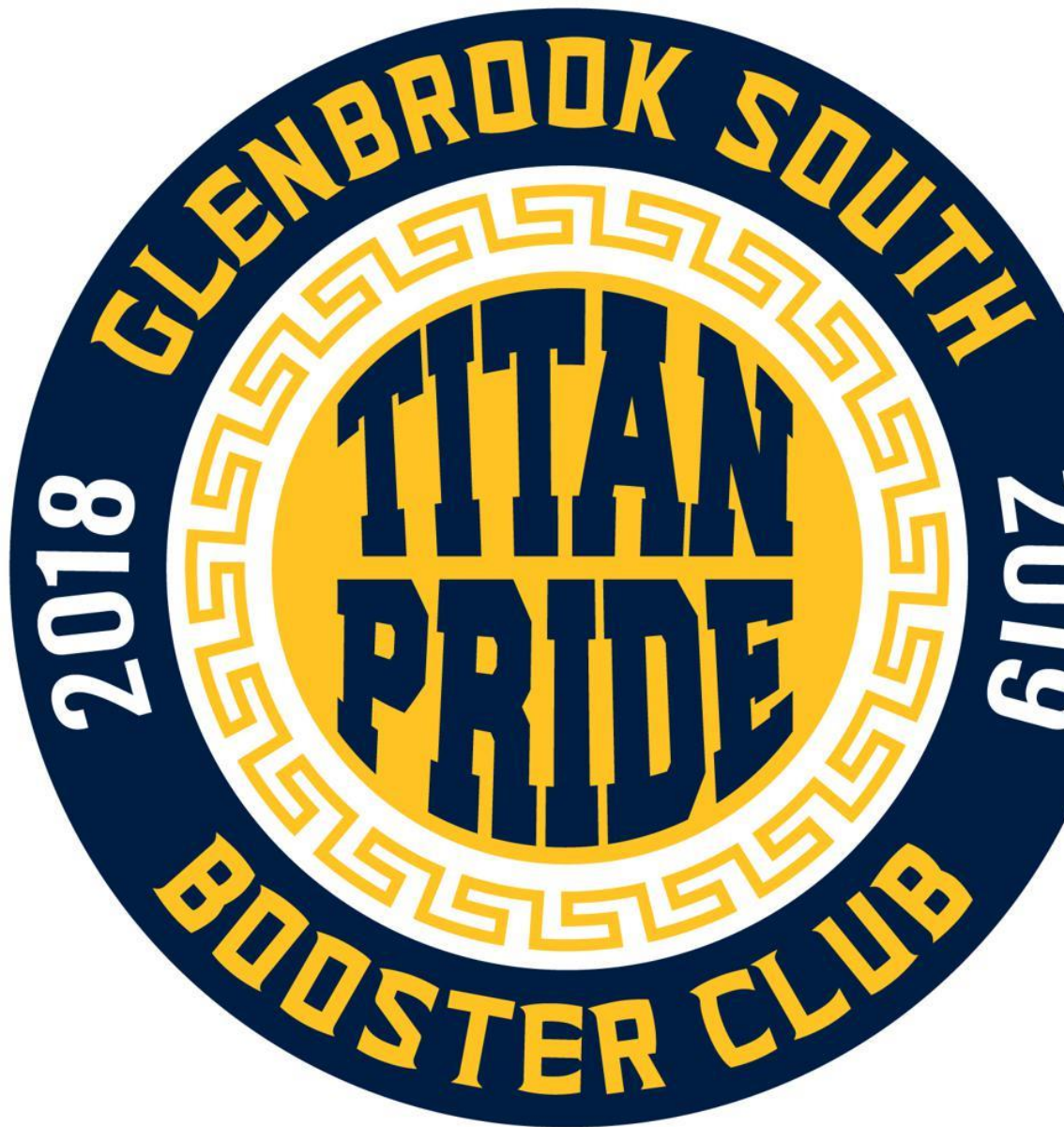
The GBS Sailing Team began its Spring racing season in April!

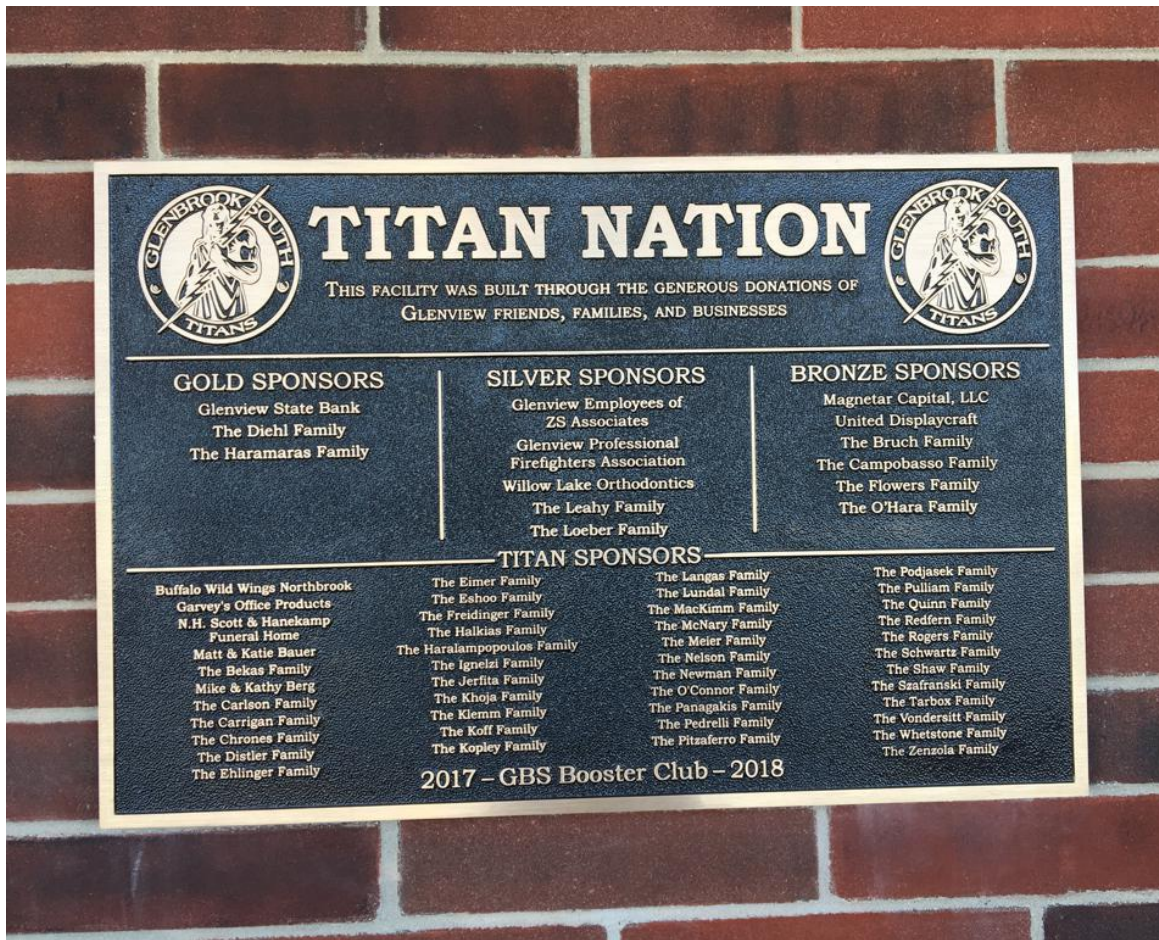
