### **3. Boys Youth Update**

Winter program wrapped up  
Spring starts March 28<sup>th</sup>; ~30 kids per grade level

Being at Calkins Road allows us to host games each weekend  
This year our field is severely limited; after forms were submitted, field space does not start until after 12:30 on Saturdays & many of the towns noted that they did not want to play after 12:30- which would mean we would need to have away games every weekend.  
Sean and Terry will stop by to meet and ask—is it miscommunication?

The town of Greece does not have a youth program anymore—collective town agreement that if a Greece athlete asks if they could play with town, all agree it's okay.

### **4. Girls Youth Update**

## **7. Unfinished Business**

Need to do inventory of lacrosse goals—Sean will do a check (none at Barker; a bunch at Calkins, some at Great Embankment and Thornell)

Consider purchasing some more goals for ease of use

Consider having all goals fixed/strung

At Barker there are usually the two heavy goals for the girls—if we use those for  $\frac{3}{4}$  or  $\frac{1}{2}$ , we may need to use the smaller lighter goals (which are on the upper fields) – right now is there is anything at Barker? Do we know where they ended up? (Calkins?)

Order six to eight 6 x 6's (seem to have plenty of 5 x 5's and 4 x 4's) \$350/each

## **8. New Business**

Need to make sure coaches have US Lacrosse Memberships

Switch to Sports Engine—can save the data from League Athletics (goes away April 30<sup>th</sup>)—like people from past- and Mike will reach out to Sports Engine to try to figure out how to get it this info transferred—what is necessary to keep?

Our Bylaws state that we charge \$25 PCLI membership fee—the first time that someone registers for a program during that time, they are charged; Sports Engine has not figured out a way to do this—Bylaws need to be updated—should we remove the fee?

For spring registration, 3.5% plus \$2—We could pass on those fees to the registrants in lieu of the annual fee—think about it
