

General Conduct

- 1) The use of alcohol or illegal drugs before or during a game by a CPHL member (as defined by CPHL By-laws) will not be tolerated. Such incidents will lead to a game misconduct and the incident will be subject to review by the Board of Directors and may result in further disciplinary action.
- 2) Any unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated on or off the playing surface. This includes obscene language, verbal abuse, threatening or inciting behavior, physical abuse or abuse of equipment. Spectators who engage in this behavior will receive one warning for their conduct. If their conduct continues to be objectionable, they will be asked to leave. If the spectator in question is a CPHL member (as defined by CPHL By-laws) the incident will be subject to review by the Board of Directors and may result in further disciplinary action.
- 3) Coaches are not permitted to verbally reprimand players or coaches from the other team before, during or after the game. If this occurs the incident will be subject to review by the Board of Directors and may result in further disciplinary action. If coaches have a concern about a situation involving the other team they should discuss it with the referees or send the concern to the Operations Committee to review.
