

Outdoor Adult Division Rules

Player requirements:

1. Must be validated USASA registrant
2. Must be registered by the stated deadline
3. Must sign Tournament Roster recognized by the League
4. All divisions, Men Open and Coed age eligibility must be met by the start of tournament play
 - a. Open – age requirements for both genders will be 18 or older
 - b. Coed – age requirements Men 30 or older and Women 18 or older
5. No jewelry
6. Jerseys or shirts MUST have a unique number (this is EVERY player, with the exception of full time keepers) and match the number indicated on the roster, NO sharing of jerseys. CANNOT USE TAPE TO NUMBER JERSEYS.
7. Player may play for **ONLY** one team
8. Players must be able to provide player eligibility to tournament staff, tournament director, or WRAS league coordinator if requested.

Basic League Rules

1. Games will be played 8 v 8 with keepers
2. Roster size - 8 minimum; 14 maximum
3. Coed will field 2 women at all times; if a team cannot field 2 females, then that team plays down a player
4. Final Adult rosters are due to adult registrar no later 5:00 pm Oct 14th
5. All teams must check in at least 1 hour prior to their first scheduled game time.
6. Spectators will be on the opposite side of the team area
7. Games are 30-minute halves with 10-minute half time; no overtime in pool games.
8. Overtime in Semi or Final games will be 10-minute halves then if still tied after overtime PK's will be taken.
9. Substitutions
 - a. Your team throw in
 - b. Goal kick
 - c. Injury
 - d. Caution is given
 - e. After a goal
 - f. Substitutions are unlimited
10. Official time is kept by referee
11. There is OFFSIDES
12. Home team is designated to change if colors conflict
13. Yellow cards will be accumulated and will be reviewed for possible action
14. Any player who receives a red card will incur a \$100.00 fee and is required to sit out their next scheduled game
15. As the definition of "Abuse and Assault" in the USSF is adopted by WRAS and will be followed
16. In the case of inclement weather, it will be the discretion lies with the tournament director prior start of the game and with the referee after the start of the game

Point System:

1. Win = 3 points
2. Tie = 1 point
3. Loss = 0 points
4. Red card = -1 point (deduct a point)
5. Forfeit = Forfeiting team -1 point and score 0 -3 Non forfeiting team 3 points and score 3-0

Tie Breakers:

1. Head to Head **
 2. Goal Differential up to 6
 3. Fewest goals scored Against
 4. Goals Scored up to 6
- **If still tied, the above sequence is followed beginning with the 2nd tie-breaker

FIFA RULES - All FIFA rules are in effect except where noted above. All decisions are final. Player with positive and safe sportsmanship, play fair, and have fun.
