

BSRA TRIVIA RULES

Before joining Zoom, please edit your Zoom account name to your Team Name.

Trivia Format:

- ④ There will be **3 rounds** of questions.
- ④ Each round will include questions from various categories. The question will be read several times so listen up! If you have many people in the room, it might be a good idea to have a paper and pen to make notes about the question.
- ④ If a question calls for multiple answers, e.g. name the 5 senses, you will receive 1 point for each correct answer (so guess if you don't know them all! Funny wrong answers gladly accepted!)
- ④ Each round will also include one Tiebreaker question, to determine the round winner. Tiebreakers will not be used to determine the overall winner, unless there is a tie in overall point totals.
- ④ After the question is read, each team will be invited to join their Team "Breakout Room" where they will have an opportunity and limited time (approximately 30 seconds) to discuss the answer privately. More time will be given when there are multiple answers in a question. Don't worry! You'll have plenty of time to answer – we just need to keep the game moving!
- ④ After the 30 seconds or so, the Host will ask you to leave the Breakout room again, all participants can leave their breakout room at any time. Once back on the main screen, one team member should type your team answer in the Zoom "Chat", please send to HOST ONLY. Again, make sure this teammate (and all) have their Team Name as the account name.

- 🌀 After each round, the emcee will announce scores for that round.
- 🌀 The highest scoring team **overall** will win the **grand prize** (or the not-so-grand prize). 😊
- 🌀 Have fun!!!

Internet/Cell Phones

Use of Internet, computers or cell phones to obtain answers is not permitted (and really, cheating at a fundraiser???) Should it be necessary to use a cell phone for a call, you are asked to hold it up to signal the Trivia host that you are taking a call and you must leave the room. Please do not re-enter the room until the next question has been read.

Judging

If the answer is a proper name, only the last name is needed to receive full credit. Spelling does not count; however, judges must be able to easily recognize your answers. More than one answer per question will automatically be scored as incorrect, unless the question requires more than one response.

The judges have the final say in determining if an answer is correct. Arguing with a judge could result in loss of points (and a possible loss of your dignity... again, it's a fundraiser!) 😊

You will be muted most of the time when the questions are being read and unmuted in your Team breakout room to privately discussing your answer. We will unmute you when reading the answers. At that time – taunting of other teams is definitely allowed – and encouraged! Most importantly... **HAVE FUN!**
