

## Park Rules and Reminders



### Parking and traffic flow

Please watch your speed in the ODC parking lots. Children of all ages run around and play at ODC so we must exercise extreme caution when driving through the park. Please do not leave trash dumped outside of your vehicle. Parking is limited and violations in parking, and trash will make the surrounding businesses limit the parking they currently offer, even further if needed. We know you may want to invite family and friends to watch your child play, **but you are responsible for advising them of the parking rules**. Please do not block anyone in; we will have you towed. If you are pulling up to drop off players or family, please do so quickly and do not delay traffic for long periods of time. Volunteers in orange, are authorized to ask you to continue moving or relocate your vehicle.

**AT Candlelight Fields/Rena** – Please do not speed through the neighborhood or down Rena St. when accessing the park. We want to be considerate of our neighbors as the park is in a residential area.

**AT Main Park/TC Jester** - Please **DO NOT ENTER through the back gate**. It is **EXIT ONLY**. The driveway through the park on the right field side of Field 1, is ONE WAY. Please do not drive from the back lot the WRONG WAY, so you can exit the front gates. ODC is not responsible for vehicles towed or ticketed that are in violation of park designated parking areas or illegal parking outside of the park on non ODC property. Please observe and follow all signs and ground markings.



## Conduct and Behavior

Players: We ask that all players respect their teammates, coaches, umpires, and ODC property.

Parents and spectators: **Please understand how seriously we take bad behavior** from parents and their guests at our club. Note that upon registration, all members have signed a code of conduct that outlines what is considered unacceptable behavior and further indicates you understand the disciplinary actions and process should an incident occur. The safety and positive experience of all the children playing in our program is directly related to our mission as an organization and we will take a zero tolerance to hate, intimidation, and violence. If you witness such behavior, please do not hesitate to bring it to our attention.

## Pet Policy at ODC

We know many of you have cute and cuddly puppies and dogs; however, **NO DOGS or pets (except trained service dogs) are allowed to be on ODC Property**. While most dogs are well mannered, it only takes one not so well-mannered dog to bite a child or attack another dog. Please leave your pets at home. **If you bring your pet with you, you will be asked to leave**. Please advise your guests of this policy also.

## Scoreboards

We depend on volunteers to assist in operating the scoreboards during games. During each game we require a volunteer of the team listed as visiting/away to run the scoreboards. Scoreboard controllers are typically plugged in and ready to go, but in the event, there is not one connected please look for an ODC volunteer in orange for assistance.

When the controller is plugged into the 3 pin receptacle the red light will be on to indicate that both the controller and the scoreboard are ready to go.

## Important Scoreboard Functions

**BALL**-This button will advance the ball indicator by one, then to blank

**STRIKE**-This button will advance the strike indicator by one, then to blank

**HOME**-This button will advance the home score digit by one. To reset the score to "0" press **RESET** then **HOME**. To enter a number i.e. 12 press # then 1 # then 2 then **HOME**

**INN**-This button will advance the inning. To reset the inning to "0" press **RESET** then **INN**.

## Other important park rules

- No Smoking on ODC property...this includes our parking lots.
- No alcohol allowed
- No riding skateboards or bikes inside the park
- No glass containers allowed
- No large coolers – we have a fully functioning concession stand with snack tickets that can be purchased for kids. See your coach for more info. (with the exception of games played when concession is not operating.
- We ask families to continue to be considerate regarding the personal space of others and maintain as much social distancing as possible
