

Test Score Eligibility Requirements for enrolling in colleges on or after August 1, 2018

The NCAA Sliding Scales for both Division I and Division II eligibility, which match the student's core-course GPA with his or her SAT or ACT test scores, are available at www.eligibilitycenter.org.

Test Score Requirements for Division I Eligibility:

- ◆ The SAT Critical Reading and Math combined score corresponding to the student's core-course GPA on the NCAA Sliding Scale.
- ◆ The ACT English, Reading, Math and Science sum score corresponding to the student's core-course GPA on the NCAA Sliding Scale.

Test Score Requirements for Division II Eligibility:

- ◆ Eligibility for Division II competition for students beginning college on or after August 1, 2018, is based on a sliding scale.

9999

Students should enter 9999 during ACT and/or SAT registration to ensure that the official scores are sent directly from testing agency to the NCAA Eligibility Center.

The NCAA Eligibility Center will not accept SAT or ACT test scores reported on a transcript.

NCAA allows "super scoring," which is the combination of the highest Critical Reading score and the highest Math score for students who took the SAT more than once. Please note that for admissions purposes, many colleges require the SAT combined score to be the score earned in one test administration.

Division I: Core Course Eligibility

Div. 1: Sixteen core courses are required for initial eligibility, including:

- 4 English credits
- 3 Math credits
- 2 Science credits
- 1 additional English, Math or Science credit
- 2 Social Studies credits
- 4 additional credits from any of the areas above or Languages Other Than English

In addition:

Ten of the 16 core courses must be completed prior to the start of the 7th semester for Division I eligibility.

- ◆ Seven of the 10 credits must be in English, Math and/or natural/physical Science.
- ◆ The minimum core-course GPA for Division I for a full qualifier and competition eligibility is **2.30**. The minimum core-course GPA for Division I **redshirt** eligibility is 2.00.

Division II: Core Course Eligibility

Div. 2: Sixteen core courses are required for initial eligibility including:

- 3 English credits,
 - 2 Math credits
 - 2 Science credits
 - 3 Additional English, Math, or Science Credit
 - 2 Social Studies credits
 - 4 additional credits from any of the areas above or Languages Other Than English
- ◆ The current minimum core-course GPA for Division II partial qualifier eligibility is 2.00. Partial qualifiers cannot compete during their first year of enrollment.
 - ◆ To be eligible for Division II **competition** as a full qualifier beginning August 1, 2018, the minimum core-course GPA is **2.20**.

Only core courses included in the List of NCAA courses for your high school campus on the NCAA Eligibility Center website, www.eligibilitycenter.org, will be used to calculate the core-course GPA.

Student-athletes must consult the official NCAA website and colleges/universities of interest to ensure the most accurate and up-to-date information.



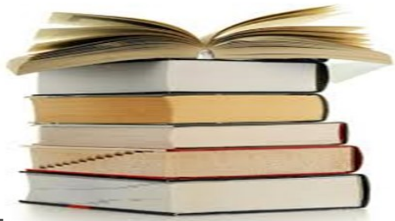
