

# Cocoa Beach Jr Sr High School (CBHS) Lacrosse Program

## Athlete Supervision Policy

### **Purpose**

The purpose of this policy is to clearly define supervision expectations for the Cocoa Beach High School (CBHS) Lacrosse Program and to ensure the safety, accountability, and well-being of all lacrosse student-athletes.

### **Scope**

This policy applies to all CBHS Boys and Girls Lacrosse teams, including Varsity, Junior Varsity, and any affiliated developmental or offseason activities that are school-sponsored or coach-directed.

### **Supervision Expectations:**

- CBHS Lacrosse athletes will be under direct supervision of a CBHS-approved coach during all practices, games, meetings, travel, and facility use.
- Coaches will provide athletes access to facilities and will be present until they are dismissed.
- Coaches will maintain appropriate coach-to-athlete ratios and provide active supervision.

### **Locker Room & Facility Supervision:**

- Coaches will supervise arrival, dismissal, and transition periods.
- Coaches will monitor locker room entrances and exits while respecting student privacy.
- Athletes may not remain in facilities or practice areas without supervision.

### **Travel & Away Events:**

- Coaches will supervise athletes during team travel and events.
- Athlete release will follow CBHS athletic department and parental authorization procedures.

### **Accountability**

The Head Coach is responsible for ensuring compliance with this policy. Assistant coaches and approved volunteers are expected to uphold supervision standards. Failure to comply may result in disciplinary action.

This policy affirms that CBHS Lacrosse coaches supervise student-athletes at all times to promote safety, responsibility, and program integrity.
