

Winnetka Ice Arena Facility Guidelines for Hockey Players and Coaches

If you, or anyone you know, is experiencing symptoms of any kind, please be responsible and stay home.

Please review **Physical Distancing** guidelines with each participant.

Each participant is required to complete and sign a comprehensive waiver before entering the facility. This requirement, once completed and signed, will not be required for future sessions.

Prior to arriving to the Winnetka Ice Arena, please know which entrance participant and/or Parents/Spectators are required to enter and exit. There are no exceptions to the entrance and exit requirements, which are as follows:

Hockey Players Enter South Door (Locker Room Hallway Door)

1. Ages 5-10 must dress at home (Mite & Squirts)
 - Mites and squirts should be directed immediately to the player benches and wait for their session.
 - Please show up no more than 10 minutes before your session.
 - Parents/Guardian my escort participant to the exterior South Door (Parents/Guardian may not enter facility at South Door.)
 - All Participants should bring own water bottle with name on it
2. Ages 11 and up, recommend dress at home, but may use locker rooms. (Facemasks Required in all areas including locker rooms, until on ice surface)
 - All Participants should bring own water bottle with name on it
 - Please show up no more than 20 minutes before your session.
 - Must wear facemasks entering facility and while in locker rooms changing

Parents/Spectators Enter Main Entrance (West Entrance)

- Facemasks are required entire time in facility
- Max of 2 Parent(s)/Spectator(s) per participant
- Parents/Guardians are not allowed in locker rooms or near player bench areas
- Parents/Spectators may pick up their participant outside at South Side door.

Goalies in each session will be provided a private space to dress for their time slot. Home dressing is required if your goalie cannot dress themselves.

Please maintain **Physical Distancing** in Locker rooms.

Overflow dress areas will be available.

Rental skates, loaner helmets and loaner hockey gear will not be available.

Vending Machines and Water fountains will not be available.

The South East "Shooting/Training Area" will not be available.

Staff/Coaches will be required to wear a facemask and gloves at all times.

Children, who are not active participants, may not be left unattended or unsupervised in the facility.

Restrooms will be limited and can only be used one person at a time. The best advice is for each participant to properly address this issue at home, if possible.

At the end of the session, the participant will put on their personal facemask and skate guards, or change and immediately exit the facility. Participants cannot congregate in the ice arena.

Participants not following these guidelines will not be permitted into the facility.

If a participant is already within the facility is not following these guidelines, she / he will be required to immediately leave the facility and not granted access to the facility for the balance of the day.
