# News & Reminders

Over 30,000 students participate in school sport each year and this week recognizes the many students, coaches, and volunteers who make it possible.

Through the cooperation of the Royal Canadian Legion, Saskatchewan Command, and our coaches, schools, and school divisions, this weekend was not only a championship weekend but also an opportunity to reflect and pay respect to those who have served, and continue to serve our country, during times of war, conflict, and peace.

## Board of Directors Ad Hoc Committees

Earlier this fall, Ad Hoc committees were formed by the Board of Directors regarding Classification, Doubles Curling, Calendar (Seasons of Play) and Program/Activity Review, Sports Academies, Education regarding player/coach/spectator conduct toward officials, and Aboriginal Coaching Modules (ACMs) logistics. # 2024 Regional & Provincial Curling

PRESENTED BY: Saskmilk

Each provincial championship will consist of eight teams scheduled as two pools of four teams in round-robin play format. The top two teams from each pool shall advance to the championship bracket. The eight teams participating at the provincial championships will include the host school and seven other teams that have qualified through the regional championships.

The tie-breaking criteria to determine placement in pool play and placement into tie-breaker games shall utilize the Skill Based Team Ranking System (SBTRS). For more information on the tiebreaker and the Saturday schedule of games, please refer to the curling activity page of the [SHSAA website](#).

Regional championships will be held March 1 - 2, 2024. The Regional championships will consist of a six or eight team double knock-out format leading to an 'A' event and 'B' event qualifier to the provincial championship. The only region that may require an A-B playoff to complete the double knock-out competition is the provincial host region. The A-B playoff will only be contested if the provincial host has not won either the 'A' or 'B' event. In the regions without an A-B playoff the 'A' event winner will be considered the Regional champion.

Districts should declare their representatives to the Regional Championships by Saturday, February 24, 2024 and contact the regional commissioners and SHSAA office following the competition.

The three provincial curling host sites were originally in three different regions thus requiring slight changes to the regional make-up for 2024. The changes were made to create the least amount of impact and continue with traditional regional groupings.

SHSAA Policy, 2.4.1. states *"As approved at the 2011 AGM, if the provincial host district is initially in a four-district region, the regions will be adjusted so that each provincial host ends up in a 3-district region. No hosting opportunities will be lost in the shuffle of districts to accommodate these changes"*.

# 2024 Regional Wrestling

**DATE:** Saturday, March 2, 2024

**LOCATION:** Rosetown Central High School

**COMMISSIONER:** Mitch Wintonyk

**PHONE:** 306-882-2655

**ENTRY:**

1. All wrestlers from registered schools outside Regina and Saskatoon **MUST** attend this meet in order to qualify for the Provincial Tournament.
2. Registered schools may enter more than one wrestler per division.
3. Every participating school **MUST** contact the SHSAA, with their intent to enter, and indicate the number of competitors by the Monday preceding the regional tournament. Competitors who have not been pre-registered by their coaches will not be allowed to participate in the tournament.
4. The Saskatchewan District team that advances to the Provincial Tournament will consist of up to four qualifiers from this meet per weight division.

**WEIGH-IN:**

A weigh-in will not be held at the Regional tournament. **Each wrestler must weigh in at their home school. A school administrator or their designate must certify the weight. Certified weights must be submitted to the SHSAA office by 12:00pm (noon) on the Thursday preceding the meet (February 29, 2024).** Note this procedure is used for the regional meet only.

**SKIN INSPECTIONS:**

Skin inspections will begin at 8:30am. All participants must pass the on-site skin inspection before wrestling.

**START TIME:**

The tournament begins at 10:00am. Three wrestling mats are available for matches.

**ENTRY:**

Regina, Saskatoon, and Saskatchewan District rosters (top 6) must be declared, and entries received by the SHSAA office on or before, Sunday, March 3rd. Changes to original entries must be made by 9:00am on Tuesday, March 5th. Upon receiving district rosters, the SHSAA office will fill weight classes one spot at a time on a rotational basis as outlined by the 'Provincial Rotation'. Before a spot is officially filled, the athlete's coach will have final discretion. Substitutions by Districts for their original entries may be made up to 12:00pm noon on Thursday, March 7th.

**SKIN CHECKS:**

On-site skin examinations will begin Friday, March 8th at 11:30am. All wrestlers must clear skin inspection prior to reporting for weigh-in.

**WEIGH-IN:**

Weigh-ins will take place on-site from 12:00 noon to 1:00pm Friday, March 8th. Wrestlers must weigh in at this time and make the weight class that they qualified in for the Provincial Championship.

**WEIGH-IN PROCEDURE:**

Check scales for the weigh-ins will be available for wrestlers between 11:00am and 11:30am.

**COMPETITION:**

Wrestling will begin on Friday at 4:00pm and continue until approximately 9:00pm. Wrestling will resume Saturday at 9:00am. The Coaches meeting will take place on Saturday during the break. Individual medals will be presented on the mat, following the gold and bronze matches. Team awards will follow the individual medal presentation.

# 2024 Conference & Regional Basketball

## CONFERENCE

- 1-3A Boys and 3A Girls will participate in conference basketball.
- Play-in games may be required for 1A, 2A, 4A Girls, and 4A Boys. These games will be scheduled after the withdrawal deadline and teams will be notified if they are scheduled for a play-in game.

### **Conference Tournaments:**

- All conference tournaments will be played the weekend of March 8 – 9, 2024 and will advance two teams to regional weekend.
- Teams designated to each conference are available on the [basketball activity page](#) of the SHSAA website.
- The draw templates for the conference tournaments are available on the [SHSAA website](#).
- Draws for the conference tournaments will be available on the SHSAA website on March 4, 2024.

## REGIONAL

### **1A – 4A Classifications:**

- The 16 teams that advance to regional play will be seeded 1 to 16 and will be placed in one of four regional tournaments in their classification.
- Each regional tournament will include a championship and consolation side with the winner of the championship side advancing to HOOPLA. Regional game times templates are available on the [SHSAA website](#).
- Regional tournament hosts will be named on March 11, 2024.
- Regional tournaments will be played the weekend of March 15 – 16, 2024.
- Schools interested in hosting a regional basketball playoff are invited to submit a bid to host on or before January 31st.

### **5A Classification:**

- In 5A, Regina will advance 3 teams while Saskatoon will advance 2 teams to the provincial tournament.
- 5A rural teams will advance three teams from a regional tournament in 2024. The draw templates for the rural regional tournament are available on the [basketball activity page](#) on the right side of the SHSAA website. A play-in game may be required for for the 5A regional tournament.
- Regional tournaments will be played the weekend of March 15 – 16, 2024.
- 5A girls regional will be hosted by Prince Albert St. Mary
- 5A boys regional will be hosted by Lloydminster

**NOTE:** Basketball withdrawal deadline is February 14, 2024.

- **Seeding forms (E-16) are due to the SHSAA office on or before February 28th, 2024.**
- The SHSAA office requires written confirmation of season results from **ALL BASKETBALL TEAMS**. Include results of all games played (tournament, league, and exhibition) including who your opponents were and the result (win or loss).
- Please include your opinion regarding the seeding of the teams in your conference as well as your opinion regarding the top 8 teams in the province in your classification.
- Any additional results following the February 28th deadline will be accepted up to noon on the Sunday preceding conference basketball.

## SHSAA PROVINCIAL BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIPS HOOPLA 2024

Hoopla 2024 will be held in Moose Jaw from March 21 - 23, 2024. The 5A boys and 5A girls preliminary games will be held on Thursday evening. All other classifications will begin play on Friday.

- **1A – 4A classifications:** The four regional champions will play a straight elimination, four-team tournament with a consolation side to determine third place.
- **5A classification:** There will be an eight-team tournament composed of three teams from Regina, two teams from Saskatoon, and three teams from the Rural regional tournament in 2024. The tournament will have a championship and consolation side.

All **finals** will be played on Saturday.

**Quadathlon:** There will be a Junior and Senior category for Boys and Girls competitions.

- 4 events (100m, 800m, Long Jump, & Shot Put) are each scored on the best performance by the individual. The winner is the competitor who accumulates the most points through the 4 events.
- Athletes participating in the Quadathlon will not be allowed to compete in other individual events at the SHSAA Championships but may compete in any age appropriate relays.
- All athletes competing in the Quadathlon at the SHSAA Track and Field Championships are expected to have competed in a similar event at their District Track Meet.
  - Shot Put implement: Boys – 12 lb; Girls – 4 kg

**HY-TEK:** The District team advancer information will be provided to each District. Entries are due to the SHSAA office on or before June 3, 2024. Substitutions for original entries may be made until 1:00pm on June 5, 2024.

**OFFICIALS' ASSIGNMENTS:** Districts shall supply officials to assist the head official at each event as shown in the table. Please forward names of your District officials to the SHSAA Office. A fine of \$100.00 will be assessed to any District that does not comply with these criteria. Athletes must not be assigned as officials (except for two rakers in Junior Quad).
