Titans Football tops New Trier

In a weather delayed, two-day game against New Trier, the Titans notched their first win of the season winning 16-7 on Saturday afternoon.

“It just means a lot to me and my team,” quarterback Michael Bauer told the Glenview Lantern. “We’ve worked hard and prepped for this. It was a hell of a week and it was so much fun.”

The two teams reconvened on Saturday after thunderstorms forced the game to be suspended after its Friday start.

South started Saturday with the ball at the New Trier 23 down 7-3 with 8:23 left in the game and drove down the field, capitalizing with a 7-yard pass from Bauer to Chris Demirlika to earn a 9-7 lead after a missed PAT attempt.

The Titans took over right after the touchdown when the Trevians fumbled on the kickoff, starting on the NT 30. South drove down the field again, this time with Bauer rushing in for a 3-yard touchdown with 48 seconds left in the game.

While dealing with the weather delays played an issue for players and coaches, at the end, it proved to be a blessing for the Titans.

South recovered an interception on the Trevians’ next drive and ended the game on a kneel.

“We regrouped, watched film, we re-gameplanned with about 10 plays we wanted to run on offense and we got it done,” coach Dave Schoenwetter said.

The Titans started the game strong, forcing a Trevians turnover on downs midfield and then drove down the field and scored on a 29-yard field goal to take an early 3-0 lead with 7:29 left in the first quarter.

Both teams struggled to score for the rest of the half, with the Titans defense forcing a couple three-and-outs.

After the Titans forced a three-and-out and ran a play, the officials paused the game because of lightning in the area. The game was delayed for 52 minutes.

The Trevians forced a three-and-out but fumbled on the punt return, giving the Titans the ball at New Trier's 19 with just over eight minutes left in the game. Play was suspended at that point.

The Titans will use the motivation to get ready for a big game against Glenbrook North. While both sides have been looking forward to the Oct. 4 game all season, Schoenwetter and his players know this could be a big game that dictates the season.

"One of the ropes that's been holding us back is that we haven't won one of these early games," Schoenwetter said. "This could be that big game that changes the way our kids think about this program."

Throughout the last week, the Varsity soccer team went 2-2. In CSL action, the Titans played against the Niles West Wolves and the Evanston Wildkits. On Tuesday, the Titans hosted Niles West for this year's Go Gold game and won with a final score of 2-1. Goals were scored by Senior Forwards Zach Ochab and Sam Rogers. Senior Forward Danny Sergiev notched both assists. Senior Goalkeeper Christian Noordover made several big saves to preserve the win.

On Thursday, the Titans traveled to ETHS to take on the Wildkits. Although the game was close with many scoring chances for both teams, GBS lost with a final score of 1-3. Scoring the lone goal for the Titans was Junior Defender Drew Maytum off an assist from Senior Defender Jose Santos-DeSoto. With the win and the tie, the Titans overall record moved to 7-3-3 and their CSL record dropped to 2-1-1 (losing their chance to win the CSL South).

On Saturday, the Titans traveled down to the Indianapolis (IN) area for the Zionsville HS Classic featuring some of the top ranked teams in Indiana. In their 1st match of the day, the Titans played against the Golden Eagles of Guerin Catholic (Noblesville, IN) and pulled off a 3-0 win. Scoring for the Titans were Junior Defender Drew Maytum off an unassisted free kick, Junior Forward Justin Leszynski and Senior Midfielder Alex Martin. Assists were earned by Senior Defender Jose Santos-DeSoto and Senior Forward Michael Sanchez. Senior Goalkeepers Christian Noordover and Aris Edlund split halves to earn the shutout.

In their 2nd match the Titans battled the Kingsmen of Penn HS (Mishawaka, IN) to a 0-1 loss. The Titans generated most of the possession and more shooting chances but were unable to capitalize on their opportunities. Senior Goalkeeper Christian Noordover and Junior Goalkeeper Coin Morse both had strong performances in the game.

The Titans' overall record now stands at 8-4-3 (2-1-1).

This week the Titans will conclude CSL Conference play at Glenbrook North (7pm on Tuesday) and will play a non-conference matchup at Leyden HS (6:30pm on Thursday).
