



NHWAY Development Fund Application

NHWAY is committed to growing the sport of wrestling in New Hampshire. In an effort to further that goal, the NHWAY Board of Directors has approved the establishment of a development fund to help clubs and teams grow organically. This notice describes the process for clubs and teams to apply for NHWAY funding grants to help start new programs or grow existing programs.

Applicants interested in applying for a grant should submit a single page proposal by e-mail in PDF format to the NHWAY Board along with a requested date to be placed on an NHWAY meeting agenda. All regularly scheduled NHWAY meetings are listed on the event calendar posted on the NHWAY.org website and usually occur on the 3rd Tuesday of the month.

Applicants will be given a 15-30 min time slot at the meeting to present the details of their proposal to the Board and answer questions from the Board Directors. The Board will then confer in a private session and vote to approve or disapprove the grant.

Applicant proposals must include:

1. The total amount of funds requested
2. The complete name and address of the legal entity that will receive funding (e.g. individual person's name, organization name, etc.)
3. An itemized breakdown of the expected items/services that will be purchased with the funds
4. Projected benefit to the growth of New Hampshire youth wrestling
