



Mission Statement: Reedville Baseball, Inc. (RBI) will provide a fun and safe learning environment for children giving them an opportunity to compete in baseball against players of equal skill and age.

As a coach representing Reedville Baseball, you play a vital role in creating a positive experience for our players, families, and community. All coaches are expected to uphold the highest standards of sportsmanship, integrity, and respect.

Coach Expectations

1. Sportsmanship

Coaches are expected to model and promote exemplary sportsmanship at all times. They shall ensure that both victory and defeat are approached with respect, integrity, and professionalism.

2. Respect for Others

Coaches shall treat all players, parents, spectators, umpires, and league officials with courtesy and respect. All interactions, whether on or off the field, must reflect the values and standards of Reedville Baseball.

3. Positive Instruction

Coaches shall provide instruction that is constructive, encouraging, and designed to support each player's development. Emphasis should be placed on learning, skill improvement, and fostering a positive team environment.

4. No Ridicule or Demeaning Behavior

Coaches shall refrain from any form of ridicule, yelling, or demeaning conduct toward players, umpires, spectators, or league officials. Communication must remain respectful and professional at all times.

5. Player Safety

Coaches are responsible for maintaining a safe and supportive environment. Any behavior or action that jeopardizes the health, safety, or well-being of a player will not be tolerated under any circumstances.

6. Compliance with League Rules

Coaches shall comply fully with all rules, policies, and procedures established by Reedville Baseball, Inc., and shall respect and adhere to the decisions made by league officials.

7. Commitment to Teaching

Coaches are expected to teach the game to the best of their ability, emphasizing the principles of teamwork, fair play, and sportsmanship, consistent with the established rules and practices of Reedville Baseball, Inc.

8. No Drugs or Alcohol

Coaches must remain free from the influence of drugs and alcohol during all Reedville Baseball practices, games, and related events.

9. No Tobacco Use

The use of tobacco products is strictly prohibited by coaches while in the dugout, on the playing field, or in the presence of players.

Disciplinary Action and Dismissal

We appreciate that all coaches are volunteers; however, the game exists for the benefit of the players, **not the adults.**

Failure to comply with this Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action by the Reedville Baseball Board of Directors, including:

- Suspension from games or team activities
- Termination of your coaching position

All coaches serve at the discretion of the Board of Directors and may be dismissed at any time, with or without cause.
