The ice schedule will not be available until end of March and will depend on the amount of skaters that register. **Each Level; 6u, 8u or 10u will have up to two evaluation skates. The 6U and 8U season will be divided evenly between games and practices. All games are all in house cross ice games. The 10U season will be comprised of home practices and games (usually three to four games) that are shared between a home and away schedule.**
