Alcohol, Drugs, and Controlled Substances Policy

Kodiak Hockey League (KHL) is concerned with the health, safety, and well-being of our players, parents, coaches, managers, referees, chaperones, and spectators, who participate in activities and represent the KHL organization. The use of illegal drugs of any kind, misuse of legal drugs and/or dietary supplements, use of performance-enhancing substances, and/or use of alcohol are inconsistent with the standards put forth by KHL.

KHL Member (Minor) Policy: KHL is a drug free environment, and its Board of Directors will enforce a zero-tolerance policy for the use of alcohol, drugs, and/or controlled substances. Participating in any practice, workout, game, function, or event under the influence of drugs (illegal or legal), alcoholic beverages, intoxicant, or narcotic substances is strictly prohibited and may be subject to disciplinary action.

Any player, coach, manager, referee, chaperone, or spectator found using, possessing, buying, or receiving illegal drugs, performance-enhancing substances, controlled substances and/or alcohol in the locker rooms, parking lots, or other locations during a KHL sponsored/sanctioned event is strictly forbidden and is in violation of the KHL Alcohol, Drugs and Controlled Substances Policy and is subject to penalties, as described in the KHL Discipline Policy and Procedures.
