Rising Opens 2021 Season at Wild Horse Pass

PHX RISING FOOTBALL CLUB vs. San Diego Loyal SC Phoenix Rising at Wild Horse Pass | April 30 Chandler, Arizona



Phoenix Rising FC at Wild Horse Pass ushers in a new area for the defending Western Conference Champions, this Friday, April 30 (7 PM on ESPN2).

"The environment created when we first opened Casino Arizona Field... The team was doing well. A couple of years later it's Didier Drogba, then it's 7,000 people. It was pretty fun," said Rising head coach Rick Schantz. "All I kind of dreamed about was taking that to the nth degree - 10,000 people. To see it actually exist now is pretty awesome."

Looking to play spoiler on opening night is San Diego Loyal, a secondyear club that went 6-5-5- in its first season in the USL Championship. One of the seven Pacific-Division opponents Rising will face four times this season, Loyal and Rising's season series accounts for four of the club's first 14 matches.

"San Diego's system is very challenging," said Schantz. "They play with a back three defensively and then are very narrow with their front three. We've spent some time this week organizing, figuring that out. They let their fullbacks go way high and are comfortable attacking with five or six players, but that's a strength but also a weakness."

Rising is coming off a 11-3-2 season in which it advanced to the final but was unable to play the match due to COVID-19. The team returns nine players from that team including two-time defending USL MVP Solomon Asante.

"We have a lot of flexibility this season," said Schantz. "What I have noticed is our top end right now, is not as sharp as I would like, but our lower third is so much closer to the top than we have been in the past. We used to talk about depth, but we really have it now. We are easily 16 players deep of players that could start at the USL level."

Completed on April 30, 2021, Phoenix Rising at Wild Horse Pass is a 10,000 seat stadium located in the Gila River Indian Community. The club's new stadium upgrades include a dedicated press box, located in the Northwest corner of the field, expanded premium seating above the East stands, an expanded West seating section. A dedicated family-friendly section was added to the North side and corner sections were created to enclose the end. A brand-new dual-sided 45 x 25 foot video board adorns the South end, behind the supporters section.

RECORD WHEN STARTING RUFAT Rising only lost once in 2020 when Rufat Dadashov is in the starting 11 -- a 2-3 loss to San Diego on Sept. 19.

That match included a disallowed goal by Dadashov after the referee ruled that the ball had struck him at midfield during the free kick that began the goal-scoring sequence. Rising's record with Dadashov in the starting 11 is 12-1-4.

PENALTY KICK PERFECTION

Rising converted all nine kicks it took in shootouts during the 2020 postseason. Goalkeeper Zac Lubin saved two opposition attempts and postseason opponents missed three of their nine attempts vs. Rising in all. The club is 3-1 in PKs all-time.

CREATORS

Asante (51) and Bakero (36) made Rising the only team to have two players in the top 10 in chances created in 2020.

DIFFERENTIAL

Rising tied Pittsburgh for the league lead in goal differential last season with +29.

MORE MOAR

Santi Moar stepped into the starting 11 for injured captain Solomon Asante on September 19, 2020 and picked up assists on both of Rising's goals.

Battling eventual Golden Boot Winner Junior Flemmings for playing time early in the season, Moar finished the campaign second on the team in assists (8) behind Solomon Asante (9) despite playing only 897 minutes, compared to Asante's 1,537.

The duo combined to score the lone goal vs. Sacramento on October 10. That was Asante's first goal since August 22, but the 2019 MVP also netted a second goal vs. Reno on Oct. 17.

HOME FIELD

Rising was 10-1-0 at home in 2020, outscoring opponents, 34-10.

40-30 CLUB

Solomon Asante is at 42 goals and 34 assists in the Championship's regular season for his career. He is only the second player to score 40 and assist on 30 goals in league history.

KING

Darnell King finished the 2020 season first on the team in clearances (49) and second in tackles won (22). He is also the only defender to have created more than 10 chances (19).

LOCAL PRODUCT

Rising signed local product Ryan Flood to a contract on March 31. The 22-year-old starred at Corona del Sol High School in nearby Tempe. Following high school, Flood traveled to Brazil and Japan in pursuit of a pro career before returning to play for FC Arizona. Flood was the coleading scorer for FC Arizona last season.

Head Coach Rick Schantz

On preseason...

For me, the focus really was, since we had eight weeks instead of six - we thought we could take our time and build volume rather than going with intensity early.

On Juan Guerra and Danny Stone...

I was really fortunate to have Juan Guerra join from Indy 11 and we bumped up Danny Stone from our academy. Danny has done a good job of moving those academy kids over to train with our first team.

On Prince Saydee...

Prince has come in and done a really good job. He doesn't quite have that bite yet, but he's going to get there. We've seen a lot of good flashes from him.

On Jeremy Kelly...

He's solid. Sometimes I feel like I need to check his heart rate. He is one of the most calm and composed players I've ever been around.

On Arturo Rodriguez...

He's the only true No. 10 we've had in a long time. I can see us dropping into a 4-2-3-1 at times with Rufat Dadashov playing up top. We have a lot of flexibility

On Andre Rawls...

I always want to have two no. 1 goalkeepers. They need to compete. I'm not a big fan of complacency. Andre is more of a reaction goalkeeper where Zac is more of an action creator. With Andre, you get a little bit more of an organizer. He's more intellectual about the game, where with Zac you have more of a beast that's controlling the box.

On Lalo Delgado...

This kid's the real deal. We may see him, if not this year, then next. We may have the goalkeeper of our future. Solo, Bakero, Aodhan... Some of the other leaders of the team came to me and said "sign Lalo." They loved him. He's one of the guys and has a great attitude. When you look at your third goalkeeper and your captains are impressed with him, it's great.

On Aodhan Quinn...

Aodhan is the most competitive player, a true leader. You love players like that. If he does his job, there is no one in the league that's gonna stop him. He feels pressure that he was a big signing for us but I've told him we wanted him because we have so much value in him as a human being. There is no pressure. The pressure is on me. He just needs to go out there and do his thing.
