

## Atlantic District Officiating Minimum Age Policy Effective June 1, 2021

Beginning with the 2021-22 hockey season the Atlantic District has implemented the following minimum age policy for officials. This policy is based on federal and state child labor laws in the Atlantic District.

- 1. To register as an official in the Atlantic District the official must reach the age of fourteen (14) by December 31<sup>st</sup> of the current season.
- 2. Officials may attend a seminar and complete the required certification requirements prior to the official's fourteenth (14<sup>th</sup>) birthday, however the official **MAY NOT**:
  - a. Register for an assigning system prior to the official's 14th birthday.
  - b. Officiate a game prior to the official's 14th birthday.
- 3. Assignors may not assign any official under the age of fourteen (14) to any games.
- 4. Returning officials who will not reach the age of fourteen (14) by December 31<sup>st</sup> of the current season will not be able to officiate games in the current season.

**Example:** An official born on December 17, 2007, will turn fourteen (14) on December 17, 2021, the official may:

- 1. Register as an official for the 2021-22 season once the USA Hockey Registration system opens in June 2021.
- Attend a seminar on any date and complete the registration requirements to receive a card and crest.
- 3. Register for an assigning system on December 17, 2021.
- 4. Officiate games on or after December 17, 2021.
