### Policy #5-2012

#### Drug and Alcohol Policy

#### **Ref A. Liquor License Act 31(2), (Unlawful or Consumption); and B. Indoor/Outdoor Turf Agreement, Beckwith Twp/SPSC Inc.**

1. The purpose of the policy outlined in this document is to ensure Players and Coaches representing the Carleton Place Soccer Club (CPSC) in area soccer leagues, tournaments, and in-house programs are fully aware of the Clubs Drug and Alcohol Policy.

2. As per Ref A, the following is an extract from the Liquor License Act:

“possession of an open container or consumption of liquor in a public place is a \$125 fine (Liquor License Act, sec 31(2)).”

3. As per Ref B, The following is an extract from the signed agreement between the Township of Beckwith and the Carleton Place Soccer Club in ref to the use of the Beckwith Sports complex.

“ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES No alcoholic beverages are permitted anywhere at or about the Landlord’s premises, other than those server in the licensed areas. Within those licenses areas, it is against the laws to serve customers alcoholic beverages to the point of intoxication or to serve minors. Tenants, its invitees and licensees must cooperate with the Landlord’s staff to comply strictly with these requirements.”

4. All Persons Registered, Playing, Coaching or in any way representing the Carleton place soccer club must adhere to subject policy (Policy #5-2012) as written and approved by the CPSC Board of Directors. Drug and alcohol use is strictly forbidden at games, practices and other associated events and will not be tolerated.

5. Breaches of this policy by any player or coach will be dealt with quickly. The Carleton Place Soccer Club reserves the right to suspend any Player or Coach from the league that has violated this Policy one or more times within one playing season. Repeat violators will be tracked and asked not to registered in future playing seasons. If a Player has been suspended for violating this policy, his registration fee will be forfeited to the club and will not be returned to the member in question.

6. Any Referee in contradiction of this policy will be reported to the EODSA/OSA. OSA policies will be used to deal with referee in question.
