Subject: Umpire Payment Process for the 2026 Season

For the 2026 season, the Little Mountain Baseball Association is updating how umpires are paid to improve efficiency, tracking, and timeliness. Applies to all games (house and post) and tournaments.

E-Transfer Payment Method 2026

- **2025 Season:** Umpires were paid in cash by team managers following each game.
- **2026 Season:** Umpires will now be paid via electronic transfer (e-transfer).

Payment Schedule

- Payments will be issued every two weeks. See calendar. Pay dates are denoted in green.
- Each pay period runs approx. Saturday to Saturday over a two-week period.

What You Need to Do to Receive Payment

- Use a valid email address that can receive Interac e-transfers. This email may belong to the parent or the child.
- Enter that same email in Assignr, as it will be used to deposit the e-transfer into the corresponding bank account. Please note – this is the same email for communications.
- Ensure auto-deposit is enabled; if not, the deposit password will be **Worldseries**.

ASSIGNR Game Assignments & Accuracy

- Payments are based on game assignments recorded in Assignr.
- If you trade or swap shifts, you must ensure the change is properly recorded.
- All changes must be communicated to the Umpire-in-Chief.
- Incorrect assignments or email details may delay or result in incorrect payments.



Umpire Payment Schedule

- Payment will be made every 2 weeks based on Assignr.
- Payments will take place from Sunday to Tuesday to the email address provided.
- Umpires or Parents will need to deposit the funds into a bank account.
- Last payment will be made in the first week of August.

1. How will umpires be paid this season?

Umpires will be paid by Interac e-transfer via an email address (first email address in Assignr). Payments will no longer be made in cash after games by team managers. The last payment of the season will occur the First week of August to close out the season.

2. Why did we make this change?

The payment system was changed to **make paying umpires simpler and easier to track**. In the past, payments required team managers to handle cash, prepare envelopes, and reconcile games after they were played. Paying umpires by e-transfer reduces this workload, improves accuracy, and ensures payments are made on time.

For our umpires this system also provides a **safer and more responsible way to receive and manage their earnings** in a cashless environment, helping them learn basic money skills with parent support.

3. Does this apply to all games?

Yes. This payment system is used for all games, including house and post season league games, playoffs, and tournaments.

4. How often will payment be sent?

Payments are sent every two weeks via Interac e-Transfer and will cover the pay periods in the Umpire Payment Schedule (shown in the grey and blue blocks). The payment schedule generally covers a two-week pay period from Sunday to Saturday.

5. When will I receive my Interac e-transfer?

E-transfers are sent between Sunday and Tuesday during the payment week. The goal for our first year is to make payments by Sunday, but given this is the first year, I have planned to make payments over 3 days (Sunday to Tuesday).

6. What email address will the payment go to?

The Interac e-transfer will be sent to the **first email address** entered in Assignr. This email address will then be used to deposit the bank account. Note: Assignr allows multiple email addresses, so the first one that is entered (which is the one for log-in is the one used for Interac e-transfer payment).

7. Can a parent use their email for payment?

Yes. The email used for payment can belong to either the umpire or the parent but must be the same email used to login to Assignr or first email in the set up.

8. Do I need to set up auto-deposit?

Auto-deposit is recommended. If auto-deposit is not set up, a password will be required to deposit the money.

9. What is the e-transfer password if auto-deposit is not set up?

The password is: Worldseries

10. How is the payment amount decided?

Payments are based on the games listed in Assignr during each pay period.

11. What if a game is traded or swapped with another umpire?

Any game changes must be updated in Assignr and reported to the Umpire-in-Chief to ensure correct payment.

12. What happens if my Assignr information is wrong?

Incorrect email addresses or game assignments may cause late or incorrect payments. Please check these to ensure that you receive payment. If you have issues with payment, please contact treasurer@littlemountainbaseball.com.

13. Optional - Free Mydoh Card for Umpire Payments (like a prepaid debit controlled through an app)

Parents may wish to set up a free Mydoh card for their child, which serves as a prepaid debit card. The umpire payments can be e-transferred to their Mydoh prepaid cards to allow them to safely spend their umpire earnings while parents can monitor activity. The e-transfer can be deposited into a parent account and then moved to the child's Mydoh card. This is optional but can be a helpful way for kids to manage their money responsibly.
