**Treasurer (Clint):**

- Clint was not present. Monthly financial report was reviewed. We are up on revenue and numbers are looking good for the year.

**President (Jack):**

- UIS will issue a check to SASA by November 10, 2021 to reimburse the \$15,000 that SASA gave to UIS to support the turf field project.
- UIS is projected to have turf by fall 2022.

**Administrator (Mike):**

- 2020-2021 dues have been paid in full
- 2021-2022 dues: 212 players paid in full. \$191,000 on line, \$80,000 on line.
- Fall work hours:

  - o Family will be charged \$50 per hour not completed

**Director – Soccer Operations (Chuck):**

- Field irrigation shut off on October 24, 2021.

- Entire complex closed on November 15, 2021 for the winter
- Work day is November 21, 2021 at 9 AM
