Our accountant offered to process our taxes for free if we put their name on shirts.

Concessions, we made \$299, with another \$200 to put in.

Chipotle and Panera fundraisers made around \$100 between both. We should try more local businesses in the future.

We need to find out who is in charge of planning the refurbishment of the fields and sit down to find out what the plans are. Sponsorship levels should be the same for next year, but Lauren proposes we add another level for sponsoring individual players' tuition. She also suggests we have a spreadsheet of corporate contacts to send out sponsorship packets to with each board member responsible for following up with around 5 contacts.
