

Major / Minor

Returning to be 10-12's from Major and Minor will be combined (keeping players together from their regular season team) and then adding incoming 9's to complete rosters as fair as possible.

The pitching mound will be 46' and the bases will be 65'. Runners can lead off but cannot steal until the 4th pitch. Runners can advance on a failed pickoff attempt or a passed ball. Batter cannot run on a dropped third strike.

All players will be in the batting lineup, but the standard 9-man defense will be utilized with free substitutions. Coaches work together to try and keep any strong pitchers from facing new to kid pitch players. Rosters are formed as evenly as possible but inevitably there may be a team or two with more returning talent. Coaches should design their batting lineup by age/talent so the opposing team can plan pitching accordingly. It is recommended to track your last out of the game and begin the next game where you left off (this helps assure all players get equal at bats through the fall).

Innings are played as 3 outs or 6 runs. 1 hour and 45 minutes hard stop (finish batter but not inning).

There will be one umpire located behind the mound.

Rookie

Incoming 7's will be placed with returning 8's to complete rosters as fair as possible. Players will be kept together with players with whom they played with during the Regular Season as numbers allow.

All players will be in the batting lineup as well as in the field every inning (extra outfielders are allowed in the fall).

The batter will have 5 pitches from his coach to put the ball in play. If after 5 pitches the batter has not put the ball in play the coach will move to a side toss. Side toss continues until the ball is put in play.

Innings are played as all batters hit but bases are cleared after 3 outs before switching offense/defense. 1 hour and 15 minutes hard stop (finish batter but not inning).

Tee-Ball

Incoming 4's and 5's will be placed with returning 6's to form rosters as fair as possible.

All players will bat and play in the field every inning. The fair circle in front of the batter is not used during the Fall and will be the coach's discretion based on the batter.

Innings are played as every player will bat and then rotate offense / defense. When on offense the batting lineup is reversed in the second inning from the first inning. 1 hour hard stop(finish batter but not inning)

Wee-Ball

There is no Wee Ball (4 yr. old's) in the Fall. 4's play Tee Ball in Fall.
