

Wasco Baseball Spring Season Draft Rules

Minor & Major leagues:

1. Each team will need one (1) Board Approved Manager & minimum of one (1), maximum of two (2), Board Approved Assistant coaches. League Commissioner will assign any teams needing a Board Approved Assistant coach prior to the draft.
2. Draft order will be determined by "Average Score" of players currently assigned to team ("predetermined players") in advance of draft. These predetermined players will be comprised of approved managers and assistant coaches.
3. Commissioner will select an independent panel to evaluate the predetermined players in advance of the draft. If a predetermined player does not participate in evaluation for any reason, they will be assigned highest score.
4. Draft order will be in descending order based on this "average score" of predetermined players.
5. Players present at the tryout/evaluation shall be drafted. Players not present at the tryout/evaluation will be selected via blind draft.
6. Rounds 1-2 will be conducted in the same order. In example, Team C has 1st pick, Team D has last pick in each of the first 2 rounds (see illustration).
7. Beginning in the 3rd round, the draft will be in reverse order in all odd rounds. In example, Team D has last pick in round 2 (not including "Additional Selections", defined below), they will have 1st pick in round 3, then last again in round 4, 1st in round 5, etc.
8. If a team has less than 3 predetermined players, they will be provided "Additional Selections" at the end of round 2. In example, Team B and C have only 2 predetermined players. Team C will select first in "Additional Selections", followed by Team B. "Additional selections" are illustrated in "red" below:

9. If a player has a sibling, that sibling will be placed on the same team. The team's 3rd round selection will be used to support any sibling placement of a 4th predetermined player. If a team has 5 predetermined players as a result of siblings, that team will also forfeit their 5th round pick in support of this selection. Note: All predetermined players will count in the scoring for draft order.
 10. If siblings are in the draft and one (1) of them is selected, that team will assume the sibling with their next draft pick(s).
 11. Players registering after the draft has been completed will be assigned to team in continuing draft order by registration date and time of registration completion.
 12. No trades will be allowed after the player is drafted. The Executive Committee may approve hardship reassignment of a player upon written request.

Pony league:

13. Each team will need one (1) Board Approved Manager & two (2) Board Approved Assistant Coaches. That league's Commissioner prior to the draft will assign any teams needing Board Approved Managers or Board Approved Assistant Coaches as necessary.
14. Draft order shall be established by random draw on the day of the draft.
15. Players present at the tryout/evaluation shall be drafted.
16. Players not present at the tryout/evaluation shall be selected from a blind draft.
17. All teams will receive a first round draft pick regardless of how many of their sons are protected. If a team's Manager or Assistant Coaches has more than one child on that team, the team shall use its third round pick of the draft for this second child. If two or more of a team's Manager or Assistant Coaches has more than one child on that team, the team shall use its fifth round draft pick and each subsequent draft round pick until it has exhausted all Manager and Assistant Coaches protected players for that team. If a Board Approved Manager or Board Approved Assistant Coach does not have any children playing in the league they are wishing to manage or coach in, then team they are assigned to shall draft two players in the fourth round of the draft – a player to fill the Manager/Assistant Coaches spot and their usual fourth round draft pick.
18. If brothers are in the draft and one (1) of them are selected, that team will assume the other brother(s) with their next draft pick(s).
19. Players registering after the draft has been completed shall be assigned to team in continuing draft order by registration date and time of registration completion.
20. No trades shall be allowed after the player is drafted. The Executive Committee upon written request may approve a hardship reassignment of a player.
