FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS: Competitive Teams

How do the assessments work?

During the assessments, players are observed by objective assessors and scored on four areas: athletic ability, soccer skills, attitude, and competitive level. The assessors provide their scores and any notes to the MUFC Technical Committee, who will prepare letters of offer to the players.

How many players per team?

The minimum number of players to run a competitive team is XX and the maximum number of players able to roster is XX .

What leagues options are available to the teams?

Huron District Soccer League (HDSL)
IModel

What is the annual commitment?

November to December: break with some teams doing some additional fitness training
January to March: two times per week
April to October: two training sessions per week plus one game per week; weekend festivals and tournaments

What travel is involved in competitive soccer?

The soccer clubs in the Huron District Soccer League are: Nipissing, Sudbury, Orillia, Barrie, South Simcoe, Collingwood, Innisville, and Wasaga. Please note that there may not be a team from each club in your child's division. The expectation is that each club with a team in a given age division will have at least one home game and at least one away game.

The teams that are in the IModel could be from a wider area, which means that travel could be further south (i.e. Vaughan, Toronto).

Who are the coaches?
