



### **MRLC Covid-19 Code of Conduct**

Murphy Ranch Little League's primary objective is to provide and maintain a safe and healthy environment for all players and coaches, while maintaining a competitive little league program. Please keep in mind that these policies are temporary and are subject to change following updates from state and local governments. All players, parents and coaches must follow these policies starting our first day of practice/clinic and until further notice.

**Per the County of Los Angeles Department of Health and California Little League District 56, players should not attend any practice/clinic under any of the following conditions:** If they do not feel well; if anyone they live with exhibits signs or symptoms of Covid-19; if the player has been in contact with someone who has tested positive for Covid-19 or if the player is considered a vulnerable individual with underlying health conditions. If a player, coach, or a member of their household of player or coach has a confirmed positive Covid-19 test, that player or coach will not be permitted back on the field until at least 10 days have passed since your symptoms first appeared AND at least 24 hours after recovery, which means fever has resolved without the use of fever reducing medications and there is improvement in your symptoms (e.g., cough, shortness of breath).

### **Practice/Clinic/Game Policies**

1. Players must be attentive and respectful of all MRLC managers and coaches.
2. While not in active play on the field, all players must adhere to CDC and District 56 6 feet social distancing guidelines as enforced by all MRLC Board Members, managers and coaches.
3. 1 hour (minimum) prior to arrival at any playing or practice field, a parent/ guardian of player must complete the on-line "Daily Health Questionnaire" BEFORE any player is allowed to participate in team practice/game. No exceptions will be made. Failure to comply will result in player being unable to participate with team.
4. Managers, coaches, team parents, scorekeepers, umpires and spectators must wear a face mask to all games or any time while on at a practice or playing facility/park.
5. Upon entering the any practice or playing facility/park, managers, coaches, team parents, scorekeepers, umpires and spectators shall use hand sanitizer.
6. Players must sanitize their hands before and after playing catch and any other drills.
7. Players may not arrive more than 15 min early for any practice/clinic.
8. Spectators at practices will be limited to one parent or guardian per player
9. Spectators at games will be limited to immediate household family members only (parents and siblings).
10. No sunflower seeds (or seeds of any kind) or chewing gum will be permitted at Murphy Ranch Little League fields.
11. Parents and immediate family members are encouraged to bring their own seats/chairs for games and need to be seated away from the players around the perimeter of the field.

12. Players must wear a face mask at all times **when not in the field of play**. This includes entering and exiting Murphy Ranch Little League property.
13. Players must bring their own equipment including: bats, hats, gloves, catcher's gear and water bottle. Gear may not be shared amongst players.
14. Players, managers/coaches, and umpires should bring their own personal drinks to all team activities. Drinks should be clearly and visibly labeled with the person's name and need to be stored in player's bags when not being used.
15. Restroom occupancy must be limited to no more than two people at a time.
16. No more than 4 players allowed in the dugouts during games. Bleachers on either the 1st or 3rd base fence line will be designated for player seating only
17. All bags must be hung outside of the dugout on either the 1st or 3rd baseline fence and must be placed at least 6 feet from any other bag. Player gear that is not being used must be immediately returned to the player's bag.
18. Players may not touch, grab, cough or spit on any other players.
19. After practice/clinic/games, players must immediately exit the Murphy Ranch Little League facility.
20. Players are expected to behave in an exemplary manner. Behavior that reflects poorly on MRLL will not be tolerated. Violation of any of these Covid-19 policies may result in formal warning, being sent home from practice/clinic/game and possible suspension or expulsion from MRLL.

By each player knowing how to properly conduct themselves, MRLL can continue to hold practices/clinics/games and focus on building and maintaining skills. MRLL thanks you in advance for discussing these policies and consequences with your player(s).
