

BY-LAWS OF THE NORTH COBB HOLE IN ONE CLUB

I. Name

The name of this organization shall be named "The North Cobb Hole in One Club".

II. Purpose

This club has been established for the purpose of promoting, supporting, improving and furthering the interest in golf at North Cobb High School.

Any funds generated by The North Cobb Hole in One Club will be used for the promotion of this purpose.

III. Objective

The Hole in One Club will conduct itself in a manner which is free from racial discrimination and which provides equal opportunity and treatment for all members regardless of race, color, religion, sex or national origin. All members should act in good faith at all events whether it be social or athletic. No Hole in One Club member or Officer shall use the Hole in One Club events for personal profit or gain.

IV. Membership

Membership is open to all persons regardless of race, sex, religion or national origin interested in furthering the purpose of the Hole in One Club. Anyone is welcome that is willing to help our group promote positive community involvement, good sportsmanship, and good fellowship among players, coaches, staff, parents and fans. Membership of the Hole in One Club may consist of, but not limited to the following groups:

A. High School players, parents, guardians, or individuals who support the purpose of The Hole in One Club and pay membership dues.

B. Honorary membership is bestowed by The Hole in One Club upon an individual who has rendered service for or to the club.

All playing members shall pay membership dues.

The Executive Board shall be made up of current Head Coaches the President and the Treasurer.

V. Finances

A. Income

1. Income shall be primarily derived from the collection of fees (dues), donations, or from fundraising projects.
2. Any changes in dues or fees recommended by any member must be approved by head coaches and treasurer.

VI. Meetings/President

A. Executive Board: The Executive Board shall meet at least once per year. The exact date and location of the meeting will be determined by the Executive Board. This meeting should be held prior to the date of any regular membership meeting.

B. General Membership: The general membership shall meet as least once per year. The exact date and location shall be determined by the Executive Board.

C. Special Meetings: Special meetings of the membership may be called when deemed necessary by the head coaches or treasurer.

D. Minutes: Minutes of each meeting shall be recorded. These minutes shall be available to the general membership.

VII. Treasurer

A. Treasurer shall perform but not be limited to the duties below:

1. Will present a budget for the fiscal year at the first fiscal meeting.
2. Prepare a quarterly financial report for the High School principal and membership.
3. Prepare an annual budget in August of each year with input from the coach and the school's administration.

VIII. Amendments

These by-laws may be amended or revised by approval of at least 3 Executive Board members present at a regular or special meeting.

IX. Dissolution

If at any time the North Cobb Hole in One Booster Club dissolves all funds will go to North Cobb High School.

X. Dispute

If there is any dispute that cannot be solved within the executive board and the general members the North Cobb Athletic Director will convene and make any needed decisions based on the best needs of the student athletes.

XI. Removal of Officers

If at any time the current the President or Treasurer is not fulfilling their obligation to the North Cobb Hole in One Booster Club the general members can vote to remove the current officers.
