There are six disciplines in disabled hockey (Blind hockey added in 2017)

- ★ **Blind hockey** – players have a visual impairment
- ★ **Hard of Hearing/Deaf hockey** – players have a hearing impairment
- ★ **Warrior hockey** – veterans who have at least 10% disability
- ★ **Standing-Amputee hockey** – players have an amputation
- ★ **Special hockey** – players have an intellectual impairment
- ★ **Sled hockey** – players have a physical impairment

Each discipline of hockey above utilizes a unique and effective means of communication, teaching, and skating in order to have fun and play hockey.

All coaches and volunteers are professionally screened; have completed specific coursework related to safety, coaching and communication in order to provide each player a safe, healthy environment at all times.
