Board Meeting Minutes

Date: September 16, 2019

Location: Petoskey Ice Arena

Christie motioned to approve the minutes from August, Brent seconded.

Treasurer Report:

2 past due accounts from last season, Charlie has taken action to give notice to those families.

Fundraising Update:

Wreath fundraiser. Forms and money due by November 1st. Wreaths will be delivered the week of November 21st. Allen waiting for pricing on wreaths to finalize the sale form.

Allen presented the business sponsorship form for 2019-2020. No changes requested. Will be posted on the website and Facebook Tuesday, September 17th.

Equipment:

Practice Jerseys: Megan will create a plan to order additional practice jerseys.

Game Jersey's: Megan requesting to order approximately 25 new game jerseys. Jerseys have already been approved in the budget, Megan will take action to get them ordered ASAP.

OneGoal Grant: \$800 to spend from MAHA to grow U8 hockey. Need is in additional hockey bags, sticks, and quick change goalie gear.

Socks: will be ordered the first week of practice when team rosters have a better estimated player count. U6 and U8 will receive blue socks, U10 and U12 will receive both Blue and White socks to math home and away jerseys.

PAHA Apparel:

Perfect Edge will be at Petoskey Ice Arena on September 20th during the Community Skate. Sample items will be available to try on. All orders will be submitted through Perfect Edge and paid directly to them. The order sheet with pricing will be sent out to association prior to the community skate night for families to review. Orders will be due the following Monday, September 23rd and were given a 3-4 week turn around. Discussion to having a second order in November, to be delivered prior to Christmas - interest will be gauged when the season begins.

Coaching Update:

All managers should be rostered on teams as well as all coaches.

Coaches meeting set for October 10th at 7:00 at Petoskey Ice Arena. Brent is communicating that to all coaching staff.

Joel Lopez has agreed to fill the void at Mini-mite head coach.

Charlie spoke with Bill Church about offering individualized instruction to goalie every other Tuesday to work with Mini, Mite, Squirt, and PeeWee coaches. Charlie will work on confirming that.

Community Night:

Open skate for all, skate rental available through Petoskey Ice Arena for \$3. Molly will manage getting cookies and drinks. Charlie and Molly will have computers set up for anyone who wants to register. Perfect Edge there will sample apparel and gear to order, with customized PAHA logo.

Try Hockey for Free, Girls Grant, Learn to Skate:

Shaun is working on finalizing the money from the girls grant last season and will have an update by the next meeting.

After much discussion, PAHA decided not to offer national Try Hockey for Free date in November. The 6 week learn to skate/IP program that ran from the beginning of September to mid-October was a great intro for hockey at a very low cost with equipment provided. This served as a much larger event to satisfy the same thing that try hockey for free day fulfilled.

Learn to Skate with Ann is beginning on October 20th. Charlie to confirm pricing with Ann. PAHA to continue to subsidize, making it more affordable for families and bringing in larger numbers of skaters. PAHA budgeted \$2000 for the fall Learn to Skate subsidies. Ann will register all players herself.

Schedule/League:

PAHA blocked home ice times for games for house squirts and Peewees prior to league scheduling meeting. Adray League scheduling meeting to be held on October 3rd at 6:00 in Gaylord for House Squirts, Peewees, and Bantams. Gladwin joining Adray league for PeeWee age this year. \$300 per team league fees, Bantams to be prorated between Kalkaska and Cheboygan.
