## Meeting Minutes

September 9, 2025

Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 5:34 PM

Approval of last meeting's minutes

Amy moved to approve the last meeting's minutes. Nicole seconded. Minutes approved.

### **New Business**

#### **1. WAHA update**

- Current registration numbers (October 20<sup>th</sup> season start ending around end February for House, end of March for Rep)

We reviewed the registration numbers for each level.

- 18U status

We will not be able to field an 18U Rep team. We discussed that there is a possibility for an 18U Rep team to be put together in the future, but we do not have the current numbers to have a Rep team.

We discussed needing to email the current 18U players registered for Rep to give them their options for their playing possibility.

- LTP registration

We discussed that we will not be raising prices for Learn to Play this year. The registration cost will remain \$125.

September 27<sup>th</sup> Gear Swap at the Equipment Room before the LTP session starts.

- Confirming the in-season ice schedule

We discussed the 18U House practice times. Once this is finalized our schedule will be set for the season. We also discussed the potential of trying to start the 18U House team a couple of weeks earlier in the beginning of October, rather than the 20<sup>th</sup>.

- Columbia Cup

We discussed the merchandise for the Columbia Cup and our current teams registered and how to get more teams registered.

- Apple Cup

We discussed the fees for Apple Cup registration and we will be raising the price \$50 for each tournament.

#### **2. Team budgets**

- Standardizing fees
- Registration fee discounts for coach's kids

We discussed what the coaching incentive would be, if that would include a discount for registration, or just reimbursement for coach's fees.

We decided that the coach reimbursement is a reimbursement for your child on the team that you are coaching/helping out with. If you have a child on another team that you are not involved with, you will not receive a discount code for that.

We discussed if we needed to cap the number of coaches receiving a discount. We agreed that all house coaches that are on the ice participating in coaching would receive a discount, but Rep teams will be capped to the coaches that will be on the bench at games.

### **3. Fundraising/Partnerships**

- LTAC application

We have submitted the Wenatchee LTAC application, and are currently working on the East Wenatchee LTAC application

- CVB savings account

We discussed moving around our savings account to a high yield savings account to get a higher interest rate. This will be confirmed and discussed with our Board next month.

The Wild will be running our LTP & ADM sessions. We need to have another agreement created soon because we have to apply November 1st for Tier 1 through PNAHA.

### **5. Safesport/Disciplinary**

Brie Adan as our VP is in charge of this committee, and each hearing will need two other Board members in each hearing.

### **6. Other Business**
