



Dear RAMMS Community,

Thank you for your continued commitment to ensuring a safe Spring sports season for everyone. We want to thank you all for your diligence in masking up and social distancing while at games.

As you know, RAMMS exists in partnership with the Madison School District as we operate on their fields and facilities. The Madison School District still **REQUIRES** all visitors on its campuses to wear a mask. You can read the district's statement in response to Governor Ducey's executive order [here](#). In order to remain in good standing with our host district, RAMMS must ask that players (while in dugouts), coaches and spectators comply with this mandate.

RAMMS is optimistic we are heading in the right direction to beat the COVID-19 pandemic and return to a sense of normalcy soon. The RAMMS Board has evaluated the current infection data and determined that the one spectator per athlete rule can now be eliminated. As long as masking and distancing are followed, RAMMS **will not limit** the number of spectators allowed at each game.

One other note on district policy is that dogs are **STRICTLY PROHIBITED**. Madison School District fields are NOT public parks, and RAMMS asks that you please abide this rule.

Thank you again from the RAMMS Board for everyone's help and compliance on these matters. This ensures RAMMS is able to continue to offer our recreation leagues well into the future.
