



PLYMOUTH YOUTH LACROSSE PARTICIPANT CODE OF CONDUCT

Youth participants in Plymouth Youth Lacrosse are to conduct themselves in a manner that demonstrates respect to other players, coaches, officials, parents, spectators, and fans. We expect that all youth participants will exhibit good sportsmanship at all times, which means that they will conduct themselves with honesty, integrity, trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring and good citizenship. Good sportsmanship will bring credit to players, their team, and our organization. It is only through such conduct that our organization can continue to earn and maintain a positive image and make its full contribution to our sport and community.

As a Parent/Guardian of one or more participants in Plymouth Youth Lacrosse, I agree that I will review the concepts of sportsmanship with my child/children and my child/children will do as follows:

1. Exhibit good sportsmanship at all times during practices, games events and activities in connection with Plymouth Youth Lacrosse;
2. Value fair play and the skills of the game above winning;
3. Respect the safety and welfare of other players;
4. Demonstrate positive behavior and respect toward teammates, opponents, coaches, officials, parents, spectators and fans;
5. Arrive at practice and games ready to devote my time and attention to my coaches and the team;
6. Demonstrate leadership on my team and to younger players; and
7. Show gratitude and care for the facilities that are generously made available for play;

On behalf of my child/children participating in Plymouth Youth Lacrosse, I realize that if my child violates this Participant Code of Conduct or any applicable New Hampshire Youth Lacrosse Association rules, my child may be subject to action by representatives of Plymouth Youth Lacrosse that could include one or more, but not limited to the following:

- Verbal warning by Head Coach
- Written Warning from Head Coach
- Player suspension from games, practices, activities and events
