Welcome and Introductions- Lots of new faces looking to get involved with the club.

House Updates -

1. Kim house update and Issues- Last week of house. Had a player end up in the hospital U4 sent a gift basket and Mom sent a thank you and is keeping Kim informed of the condition. Winter house has 190 registered so far. Sahlens has not told us what the spectator rule is going to be but think it will be 2 per player. Kim has communicated since Sahlen is only allowing 1 spectator per player U11 and under. No spectators for older kids.

BWNYJSL updates- Chuck

1. Board meeting was 10/5/2020. U8 will be a pure U8 format with 4v4 no goalie, max 8 kids per team. No club pass or duo carding. Another option is the team can register in U10 if club does not have enough for pure U8 age but need to understand that they will be playing with older kids that can club pass and duo card. In order for pure U8 to continue they must have a min of 6 teams signed up for the division to work.
2. Older kids 2001- the decision was made to not allow those kids to make up their missed year. Not enough kids to create a separate division suggest they play in the adult league.
3. New negotiated ref contract. Due to this there will be an increase in fees. Buffalo paid lowest rate for refs the new contract brought them up to middle of the pack. The fees will be based on age divisions. Younger teams rate will go down older age will go up. Increasing rates to \$165.
