With the addition of the FC 1974 Elite Program, players with the aptitude of the highest level will now be able to attain that competitive advantage here at GLSA. All players must be committed to attending training and games, as well as developing skills on their own. Players will be selected to the 1974 team based on their technical, tactical, mental and physical soccer abilities and are assessed by the GLSA Professional Coaching staff throughout the prior season and during the tryout process.
