

PPO is a volunteer run organization that has served the youth of Pembroke Pines since 1968. Our primary mission is to "bring out the best in youth." Our Heat Strikers program is designed to allow our participants to compete and learn the game of soccer at a higher level than our recreational program can offer, while at the same time making it affordable to the families that we serve.

However, the costs for travel soccer are inherently more than what it costs to play in our recreational program. Your registration fees cover the uniform and playing one season in the South Florida United Soccer League, which typically has games from October to February. **In addition to the PPO registration fee, there will be additional costs.** This varies greatly from team to team, and is based on how many tournaments your team will attend. Each team's coach will coordinate with parents to attend these outside events. The costs will be shared equally by all players who attend. Some teams, but not all, may travel and incur hotel and travel costs. Please speak to your coach to get more information on this. Remember, this is a TEAM effort. Parents as a whole will help determine how many (or how few) tournaments the team will attend, and this will evolve as the team progresses through the season.

Offsite activities liability waiver

Your coach has volunteered to coach your team a minimum of two times per week (weather permitting), as well as attend all South Florida United League games. Coaches are not paid by PPO, nor may they charge you for these services. Coaches are also not permitted to charge you for any training services conducted in our park (Pines Recreation Center), or any other park in Pembroke Pines. Some coaches may offer you the opportunity to get additional training offsite (not in our park). If your (or any other) PPO coach offers you an opportunity to participate in offsite training, you are **not** required to pay for or attend them.

If you choose not to participate in any offsite training activities that might be offered to you, your ability to practice with your team at PPO and play in all league games will **not** be affected. Training activities that are conducted outside of our park, which includes offsite training, are not part of the PPO program.
