

Visitors' Guide to Rink Rules at Ice Dawgs' Hockey



Introduction

The MayPort Area Ice Dawgs welcome you to our arena. To comply with the ND Smart Restart guidelines and provide a safer environment for participants, spectators, and workers, the following guidelines will be in place at the MayPort Youth Center. In addition, each opposing home school district has established their own guidelines regarding spectator attendance which will result in varying numbers of spectators allowed. We intend to publish opponent guidelines on our social media sites but ask that you understand that all guidelines are subject to change. Please be sure to check guidelines prior to leaving for a contest to ensure compliance.

If you are not feeling well please refrain from coming to the MayPort Youth Center.

The Building

Attendance

The MayPort Ice Dawgs arena has a capacity of 1066 occupants (not including the ice surface). The MayPort Ice Dawgs will follow the ND Smart Start Large Gathering Tiered Capacity Plan located here: <https://ndresponse.gov/sites/www/files/documents/covid-19/ND%20Smart%20Restart/NDSmartRestart-LargeGatheringTieredCapacityDoc.pdf>

At this time, the arena will limit spectators to 150 occupants for events. We encourage visiting teams to limit attendance to immediate family only.

All fans are required to follow ND Smart Start guidelines regarding social distancing requirements.

Mask wearing

Mask wearing is REQUIRED at all times; from entrance to exist for all spectators, coaches, and officials. Players are required to wear masks at all times, other than when on the ice.

Concessions

Concessions will be open. All concession workers will wear masks and use gloves as appropriate, wash hands, and sanitize preparation and eating spaces often. Spectators are to please use social distancing procedures in the concessions' room and upstairs; use hand sanitizer before and after eating; and ensure all food containers are properly disposed of.

Concession workers will complete extra sanitizing measures in public spaces before, during, and after games.

Bathrooms

Use good hand sanitation.

Locker rooms

Locker rooms will be open to visiting teams 30 minutes prior to game time. Please make all efforts to avoid crowding while moving through the arena's walkways while entering the building.

Players will need to use extra effort to ensure their equipment is located near them, and not strewn about the locker room. Players shall keep their distance from other players as much as possible. Mask wearing is encouraged in the locker room. It is recommended that players dress as much as they can prior to arriving at the rink. There will be absolutely no eating, gum chewing, or spitting in the locker rooms.

Representatives of Ice Dawgs' Hockey will sanitize locker rooms both before and after use by visiting teams.

We encourage each visiting team to follow their own locker room policies while visiting our rink.

Bench

Coaches are encouraged to wear masks on the bench. There will be absolutely no spitting on the bench.

Coaches' rooms

Coaches are required to wear masks while in the coaches' rooms.

The Players

Players shall limit contact with other players as much as possible such as getting mostly dressed prior to arriving at the rink, reduce restroom use, and staying in their spaces in the locker room. Players should avoid touching other players' equipment. Spitting is not allowed. All players need to bring their own water bottles and shall not share. The MayPort Youth Center will have a bottle filling station on the north end of the rink. No general usage drinking fountain will be available,

Spectators

Maintain social distancing measures at all times and follow all other building rules and guidelines posted around the building. Practice appropriate sanitizing measures including washing of hands, use of hand sanitizer, wearing masks, and all other building rules. Do your part sanitizing, cleaning, and enforcing rink rules.
