# GLOSSARY OF TERMS

**Assist** - Point awarded to a player for helping set up a goal, usually to the last man or two men to handle the puck prior to the goal.

**Back Check** - Forwards in the enemy zone pick up their checks and skate back quickly to their own end of the ice to protect their goal and keep the opponent from shooting.

**Body Check** - Slowing or stopping an opponent with the puck by using hip or shoulder (legal).

**Blue Line** - Encloses the attacking zones on each end of the ice. The puck must precede an attacking player into the zone.

**Breakaway** - No opponent between the puck carrier and the opposition's goal except the goalie.

**Comers** - Four curved areas of the hockey rink where a great deal of action takes place.

**Crease** - The semi-circle in front of the net, approximately four by eight foot in size. A goal is not allowed if any offensive player is within the goal crease.

**Clearing The Puck** - When the puck is passed or shot away from the front of the net or congested area.

**Centering The Puck** - When a player passes the puck into the slot area.

**Dangle** - To make a dusty move.

**Deke** - A fake by a puck carrier to stickhandle his way around an opponent or to make the goalie move out of position.

**Drop Pass** - Player moving up the ice with the puck deliberately leaves the puck behind him for a trailing teammate as he continues to skate forward.

**Even Strength** - When both teams are playing with the same manpower.

**Extra Attacker** - The player that comes off the bench when a team pulls the goalie.

**Hat Trick** - Three goals scored by a player in one game.

**Sweep Check** - To use the entire length of the stick with a sweeping motion while laying it flat on the ice in order to dislodge the puck from the puck carrier.

**Wrist Shot** - Propelling the puck off the blade of the stick with a flickering motion of the wrist.

**Headmanning** - Passing the puck ahead to a leading teammate.

**Neutral Zone** - The central ice area between the defending and attacking zones enclosed by the two blue lines.

**Point** - A position just inside the opposition's blue line, close to the boards on either side of the rink, usually manned by defensemen when their team is in control of the puck in the opposition's zone.

**Face-Off** - To start the play at any time, the puck is dropped between two opposing players facing each other. Time starts when the puck is dropped.

**Flip Pass** - Pass the puck to a teammate by raising it a few inches off the ice and over the blade of the opponent's stick which may be in the way of the pass.

**Forecheck** - Hustling in the opponent's defensive zone by the forwards who want to keep the puck there and hopefully take it away.

**Full Strength** - When a team has its full complement of 5 players and 1 goaltender.

**Freezing the Puck** - Holding the puck against the boards with the stick or skates.

**One Timer** - When a player on the receiving end of a pass wastes no time setting the puck but instead unleashes a shot.

**Poke Check** - To dislodge the puck from the puck carrier by stabbing at it with the blade of the stick.

**Power Play** - The play that occurs when a team has the advantage of an extra man or men because of a penalty to the other club.

**Pulling The Goalie** - A team that is losing will sometimes take the goaltender off the ice in favor of another forward, most frequently occurs near the end of a game.

**Screen Shot** - A shot when one or more players are between the shooter and goal, thus blocking the goalie's view of the play.

**Shorthanded** - When a team is playing with less players than the opposition.

**Sin Bin** - Another name for the penalty box.

**Slap Shot** - When a player winds up prior to taking a shot and follows through completely while pivoting off of one skate.

**Slot** - The area directly in front of the goal from the crease to the top of the face-off circles.

**Smothering The Puck** - When a goalie or other players fall on the puck and cover it - only legal when done by the goaltender or accidentally by another player.

**Snap Shot** - A high-powered wrist shot released quickly and unexpectedly to the goaltender.

**Stick Handling** - Carrying the puck along the ice with the stick.

**Splitting The Defense** - When a player successfully carries the puck between two defensemen.

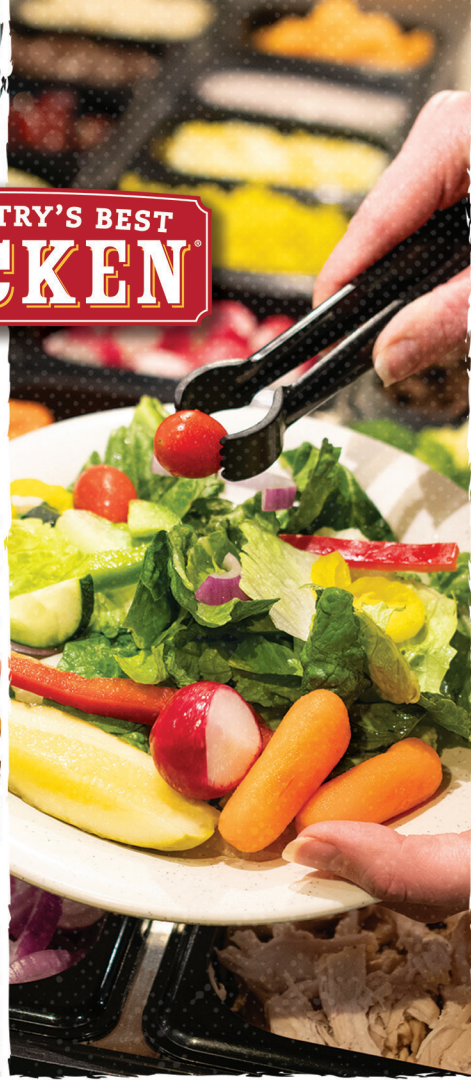
