Treasurer's Report:

Troy presented the treasurer's report. Sponsorship money has come in sooner this year. Tournament fees are up due to increasing the tournament sizes. We are waiting on payment from only 2 teams so that is great. The full financial report is attached.

Old Business

1. Adult League

After our decision was made last month, a few members of the adult association reached out to members of the board. They were confused as to what happened as nobody had reached out to them to let them know about the decision to separate ourselves from them. We have been in contact with them and are working with them to get all of their certifications in place so they can be free-standing next year. Troy motioned to rescind the motion from our October meeting. Courtney seconded the rescinding of the motion and all were in favor.

Dan motioned we will allow the adult league to continue to operate under our association as they work toward separating from us. They must continue to work towards completion of creating a separate entity for them to operate under. Alyssa seconded and all were in favor.

2. Half Ice Boards

Wenatchee has the boards. They want us to come and get them which is a little frustrating but we need to get it done. We need to get them on Sunday so this is done. We said that we are ok with them borrowing them for their tournaments but they need to be responsible for picking them up and returning them. Troy will reach out and schedule the pick-up time. Tri-Cities reached out asking if we are doing a 10u tournament. They are having a hard time finding tournaments to go to. They would love the ice time and a chance to bring several teams up as well as some teams from other locations. The potential date for this would be January 24-25.
