

## HYS Weather Guidelines

- Rain- Games will be canceled when the fields are not playable. We will give our best effort to get games in, and sometimes games will be called at the last minute. For rain during games, a board member will make the call to cancel.
- Lightning- In the event of lightning, game play will be stopped for 30 minutes. If there is another strike, the clock will start over at 30 minutes. A board member will make the decision to call the games if lightning continues to be present.
- Severe weather watch- We will watch the weather closely and try to get our games played. A board member will make the decision on calling the games during a watch.
- Severe weather warning- Safety is our priority and a board member will determine if the warning affects the area and cancel the games or temporarily hold until the warning expires.
- Umpires may temporarily suspend the games at any time to converse with a board member to determine the appropriate action during weather events.
