Volleyball Tournament Format Information

1. Time-outs will be 60-seconds in length. The home team is listed first on the schedule. A coin flip will be used for serve/side under the discretion of the R1 (lead official).
2. For team warm-ups we will be doing the following:
 - a. Two Minutes Shared
 - b. Four Minutes Serving Team
 - c. Four Minutes Receiving Team
3. Warm-up volleyballs will not be provided. Please bring your own!
4. There will be one head official (R1) for each match provided. When your team is officiating, you need to supply one official (R2), two scorekeepers, one scoreboard operator and two line-judges. Please work with the R1 for assigned tasks. Parents and guardians are allowed to help with officiating duties (prefer scorekeeper and if needed line judges).
5. Every team will play at least four matches, all best 2 out of 3 with the first two sets to 25 points and the third set to 15 points. No cap in any set.
6. JustAgame Fieldhouse uses Exposure Volleyball for scheduling and for results. Both can be found at <https://volleyball.exposureevents.com/youth-volleyball-events>. The name of the event is the JustAgame Dunkin' Donuts Invite.

Tournament & Venue Information

1. For tiebreaking procedures that involve bracket play, we will be using PROTOCOL #1.
For all two-way ties:
The #1 team will be the team that won the pool play match between the two tied teams.
All other ties:
Teams qualifying for playoffs shall be determined by:
 1. Match Winning Percentage (Matches won divided by matches played)
 2. Set Winning Percentage (Sets won divided by sets played)
 3. Total Point Differential (Total # of points won subtracted from total # of points lost)
 4. Coin Flip
2. Spectators, officials, players and coaches **are not required** to wear masks while they are in the building or when playing. If your team is required to wear masks please do so. If spectators are not comfortable with this policy, please take advantage of our live streaming option.

3. Live streaming costs \$8.00 per day and you can select multiple courts to follow the athlete throughout the tournament. The link is <https://justagamelive.com/clients/justagame-fieldhouse/schedule>.
4. We will not have an athletic trainer. We do have minimal first-aid supplies in the concession stand and ice available.
5. Teams, please pick up around your bench and where you “set-up shop” in the bleachers or in the balcony. Do not “set-up shop” in the lobby area by the concession stand.
COACHES/PARENTS PLEASE ENFORCE THIS!
6. Doors will open at 7:00 a.m. on Sunday at JustAgame Fieldhouse and 8:00 a.m. at Wisconsin Dells Middle School.
7. Admission prices for the tournament are \$8.00 for adults and \$4.00 for grades K-12. **YOU DO NOT HAVE TO PAY FOR PARKING!** The City of Wisconsin Dells only charges from April 1st to September 30th.
8. We do not have a parent/spectator limit so it will be crowded. If this is worrisome for you, please stay home and enjoy the matches via our live-stream option. **We are thrilled to be able to host tournaments without a spectator policy and provide an opportunity for you to watch your athlete in person.**
9. Teams will chase after their own volleyballs during their warm-up time. Line-judges should not chase after the game ball during their officiating time.
10. Teams will not switch sides of the net after each set. Teams will recognize each other before and after the match with a hand wave across the net. The R1 (lead official) has the discretion to ask the teams to switch sides of the net during the third set if they feel like one side has an advantage.
11. The Court of Champions is located straight ahead as you enter the facility for the Wilderness/Pizza Pub and Dunkin’ Donuts/Mallards Courts.
