Update/create new budget sheet: Josh Culbetson

Monetize websites/sponsors:

- Increase in expenses may be to the point of raising league fees
- A sub committee should be created to look at monetizing our website and collecting sponsorship money to avoid raising league fees...or not?

Player Stickers/Sub Guidelines:

Overview: to create a simple check in system to ensure players have registered with the MCAHA and USA hockey in order to participate in league sanctioned events.

Stickers:

- One season/division sticker for every registered player i.e.
 - Rec 21-22
 - Adv 21-22
 - Elite 21-22*STICKER FOR THE PLAYER*
- Tape on helmets to designate top players for each division
 - Red tape for C players in rec
 - Blue tape for B players in adv
 - Green tape for A players in elite
- No player may participate in a game unless they have appropriate sticker
 - Officials should confirm all players I have the appropriate stickers and remove any player with incorrect sticker or no sticker
- Discipline needs to be outlined for captains that may give stickers to unregistered players
- Discipline for players receiving a sticker, but not registering with the league
- Process for distributing stickers should be discussed
 - Does Centennial still have the bulletin board?
 - If so, is there a camera pointed in the direction?

Sub players:

- If a team has less than 10 players they may recruit subs
 - Sports engine game attendance function should be utilized by teams to help decide if a sub player is needed
 - Discipline for any team that has a sub and more than 10 skaters
 - Sub player must be registered with the league and that specific division
 - I.e. 7 and 8 rated players only registered in elite would be ineligible to sub in advance
 - I.e. 4 and 5 rated player only registered in advanced would be ineligible to sub for rec
 - Teams cannot go over the agreed-upon amount of top players for the season playing guide
 - I.e. rec team may not recruit a C level player to sub if all four of their C players show up
 - Since all top players will be marked, it will be easy for captains and referees to identify if teams are trying to stack
 - Discussion points:
 - jerseys for sub players
 - Scoresheet/SportsEngine i.e. how to tell roster vs sub player
 - Discipline for teams that abuse sub player privileges
