



# *Protocol for the Return to Rowing*

## *Site Protocols - Participants*

### *General*

- Athletes and parents are not permitted to pull into or park in the BSRA lot
  - Drop-off/parking is allowed within the Ohio Street parking spaces
  - Stopping in the middle of traffic in front of the boathouse is strictly prohibited
- The BSRA boathouse and locker rooms are closed to all athletes and members
- Athletes should limit personal items they bring to practice
- Masks must be worn on the BSRA site (unless athletes are doing socially distant exercises)

### *Arrival*

- Masks must be worn upon arrival to the 405 Ohio Street site
- Coaches will take temperatures of athletes
- Coaches will assign boats and corresponding oars to each athlete
- Masks must be worn while athletes are collecting equipment and going down to the dock
- Athletes are encouraged to utilize hand sanitizing or hand washing stations before a session

### *Practice*

- Masks may be removed once the athlete(s) leaves the dock
- Masks must be worn upon arrival to the dock following a session

### *Departure*

- Athletes are responsible for cleaning their oar handles following a session
  - Coaches may instruct athletes to leave oars on the dock or to take oars back to the container
- Boats must either be safely brought onto the dock (wavecutters only) or put away and strapped down
- Athletes must continue to wear their masks while on site amongst their teammates and coaches
- Athletes are encouraged to utilize the hand sanitizing or hand washing stations before leaving
