Breezy Point Sports Arena

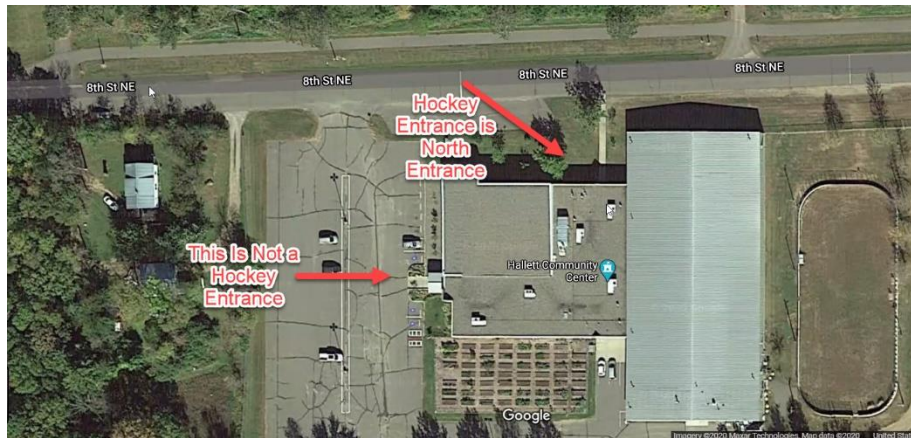

- Per the state mandate, cloth face coverings (masks) must be worn by everyone inside an arena at all times. This includes participants during on-ice practice and game play.
- Locker rooms may not be used. Players should put skates on in designated areas of the arena that provide for social distancing.
- No equipment bags will be allowed in facilities with the exception of goalies.
- All players must arrive to the arena fully dressed, with the exception of skates, helmet and gloves.
- Players must not enter the arena prior to 10 minutes before the start of their scheduled ice time. They must exit the arena no later than 10 minutes following the conclusion of their ice time.
- Spectators will be allowed in arenas for tournaments. We ask that spectators remain immediate household to the player only. These spectators must be masked and socially distanced from others.
- Dryland activities will not be allowed inside the arenas.
- Only active players and 3 coaches are allowed on the bench during game play. Players who are unable to participate may not be on the bench.
- Coaches must wear a mask while on the ice or on the bench for all games and practices, unless they have a pre-existing medical condition which should be communicated to their association leadership in advance.
- Players who are instructed to quarantine by public health will be considered ineligible for participation for the duration of their quarantine period. If a player instructed to quarantine plays in a game, rules subject to playing an ineligible player shall be enforced.
- Breezy Point Arena does offer LiveBarn.

- The ONLY Hockey Entrance will be the north doors. These are the glass doors facing the road and are at the end of the hallway where locker rooms are located.



- The ONLY Hockey Exit will be the other set of north doors facing the road inside the arena.
- Masks are required to enter the facility and need to be worn in common areas.
- Hallett Center serves not only us, but other groups of all age ranges and are trying to protect all. A separate entrance for us from the fitness and pool patrons is another safety measure they've added.
- You may be asked to take a temperature check.

Watching Games

- Per the state mandate, cloth face coverings (masks) must be worn by everyone inside an arena at all times. This includes participants during on-ice practice and game play.
- Locker rooms may not be used. Players should put skates on in designated areas of the arena that provide for social distancing.
- No equipment bags will be allowed in facilities with the exception of goalies.

- Spectators should queue up 5 minutes prior to the scheduled time for check-in and temp checks.
- There is 1 spectator allowed per player with a maximum capacity of 62. Hallett staff will be staffed at the door.
- Hallett Center will offer LiveBarn this season during games so you can watch/stream as another option.
