

2026 NeoBaseball All-Star Games

In 2026, the 14th consecutive All-Star Game/s will be held for **9U, 10U, 11U, and 12U** Neobaseball Recreational League Teams. Below is the information regarding the exhibition games:

- **Each Team Manager shall submit (online registration) the following information by June 12th:**
 - Age Classification & Team Name
 - Contact Information
 - Player Name (correctly spelled)
 - Preferred Positions
 - Player Jersey #
- Each age classification listed above may play one All-Star game (there will be no additional cost to players/teams). There are no all-star games held for CP, 8U, 13U or 14U baseball.
- Each Neobaseball rec 9U, 10U, 11U, & 12U team will have the opportunity to send TWO players to the All-Star game
- For the most part, All-Star Teams will be determined based on regular season record standings (All-Star team “X” shall include the following team seeds: #1, 4, 5, 8, 9... All-Star Team “Y” shall include: #2, 3, 6, 7, 10...)
- All-Star Team Managers will be selected based on several factors like the team’s standings, overall sportsmanship, and involvement with the league.
- The All-Star team Manager/s shall select up to 3 Coaches from other participating teams to assist in coaching (the manager can use only one of their own assistant coaches if they want)
- Practice(s) shall be determined by the All-Star Team Manager, if applicable (coaches may or may not have practice prior...some just have the kids there early game day)
- Scheduled dates/times:
 - 9U – 7/11/26 (3pm start)
 - 10U – 7/11/26 (7pm start)
 - 11U – 7/11/26 (1pm start)
 - 12U - 7/11/26 (5pm start)
 - 7/12/26 reserved for rain-out
- An All-Star hat will be provided to players/participants –there will be 2 colors, one color per team (players should wear their community uniform to the game & take their catcher’s gear, if applicable).
