



2018-19 Ice Time Guidelines and Expectations

We are very excited to host you and your team for yet another season. As always, there are very important rules and expectations to keep in mind at all times while you, your players, your families, and your opponents are a guest at Gila River Arena. The use of the arena is a PRIVILEGE and so the failure to obey the rules can result in discipline including, but not limited to, the loss of ice time or removal from the building. Please review the below rules and as always, we thank you for your support and look forward to another awesome season!

Arena Conduct

- Obey all signs in the arena and directions from security personnel and/or arena staff at all times
- Parents or spectators may not enter the ice or the service level of the arena at any time without permission from a Coyotes and/or an arena staff member
- Alcohol and drugs are not permitted in the arena at any time
- Misuse, vandalism, or destruction of arena property will not be permitted and you will be held responsible
- No weapons, violence, fighting, threats, or inappropriate language will be tolerated
- No trespassing in restricted arena areas
- Dressing Rooms must be treated with respect and thoroughly cleaned after every use

Day of Skate Expectations

- Parking will be in the available lots around the arena and **NOT the immediate visitor or reserved spaces along the West side of the arena.**
- All Participants and spectators will enter through Gate 3 at the Northwest corner of Gila River Arena and will go through a security screening and bag check.
- Players/coaches will be escorted to dressing rooms by a Coyotes representative up to 45 minutes prior to the start of your practice or 60 minutes prior to a game. Spectators may enter up to 15 minutes prior to the first ice time of the day.
- **Seating for spectators will be in Section 111 and 112 ONLY**
- Unfortunately, the in-arena Wi-Fi is a private network and will not be available for public use
- Specific dressing room assignments are subject to change at any time depending on arena use
- Players are not permitted to use arena elevators at any time unless given permission or because of an injury, and must use the stairs at Gate 3 to get up/down from the service level
- Spectators must exit the arena as soon as the final ice time of the day is complete but are permitted to wait outside Gate 3 for the players and/or coaches
