Andy Murray —Head Coach

Served as Head Coach for the Los Angeles Kings and St. Louis Blues of the NHL before coming to Western Michigan University. Also has Coached Canada to three IIHF World Championship gold medals. In May of 2012 Coach Murray was Inducted into the IIFH Hall of Fame for his accomplishments.

Dave Shyiak — Associate Coach

Most recently served as an amateur scout for the Toronto Maple Leafs, prior to that spent eight seasons as head coach of Alaska-Anchorage and prior to that was assistant and associate head coach at his alma mater Northern Michigan. From 1993-2001 spent time as head coach and general manager for various Junior Hockey League teams.

Todd Krygier— Assistant Coach

Most recently served as Head Coach for the Muskegon Lumberjacks of the USHL, prior to that he coached at Novi high school for seven seasons and was named MSHCA Division I Coach of the Year helping the program to their first state championship. He appeared in 543 NHL games mostly with the Washington Capitals and his college career was at UConn.
