Initial Discussion:	<p>While not a desired approach, there were some UAHA board votes conducted by email, due to the urgency of the issues and / or the sensitive nature of the subject. These were:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Discussed in Jan 2026 open meeting and sent to vote by the board – “To adopt the new amounts (in the new P and Ps) on the number of out-of-state tournaments for tournament rosters and travel teams to go into effect immediately.” <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o 7 votes received – 7 yes and 0 no - Discussed in Jan 2026 open meeting and sent to vote by the board – “To allow multiple tournament rosters for one age group within an organization, with the caveat that players cannot double roster onto multiple tournament rosters.” <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o 7 votes received – 7 yes and 0 no - The formation of the “Team Utah Committee” – Geoff Fisher (Chair), Kathleen Smith, Robyn Eyre-Long, Randy Abbey, Kayden Nielsen, Kristen Bowness, Nate Martinez <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o 10 votes received - 7 yes and 3 no - An additional meeting was held to discuss the Ogden 18U Tier II team regarding an anonymous concern received for player / team eligibility due to a potential out of state player being billeted. It was reiterated that this was not overly straightforward, based on the evidence reviewed, with some personal information sensitive detail discussed, hence the need for the closed session. Geoff reiterated that the desire is to be transparent, but not all details can be reviewed publicly for situations like this. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o The result of the UAHA discussion was a vote to determine the player ineligible, but declare the team ineligible- This was approved, with 9 voting (2 recusals, 4 yes and 3 no) o With the UAHA decision on player eligibility, the state and district registrar ruled the player ineligible for play. o The player and team appealed to the National Tournament Eligibility Committee who ruled in favor upholding the UAHA decision (player ineligible, but team can play without him)

Initial Discussion:	<p>This was a call held with UAHA and UHSH leadership, to discuss the 4 areas where high school hockey questioned the content of the P and Ps (approved in Jan 2026). Based on input from the HS Board, the desire was to have an open to the public discussion about UHSHs concerns. While the meeting was open, it was structured to only permit the HS Exec board and UAHA Exec Board the ability to speak. Although there was mixed reviews on it, the zoom chat was disabled in the meeting room as well. HS was notified of this in advance, so they could establish an internal group chat with the trustees.</p> <p>A summary of the discussion, Anna offered that High school had 4 concerns they pushed back on, as detailed in the minutes.</p> <p>The meeting was believed to be long overdue and allowed for alignment of the purpose of high school and how they fit into the landscape. HS has committed</p>

	<p>to review the policies and agree among their trustees on what needs to be pushed forward as an amendment. This will be submitted ahead of the required 11 Feb 2026 deadline.</p> <p>Geoff explained that the purpose of much of this effort is to increase the number of multi-generational players in the state, by providing everyone with experience. There are a limited number of ice sheets, and the ask of UHSH is to reduce their footprint on ice utilization – including reducing the number of players rostered on multiple teams – to permit more opportunities to offer an experience for the level of growth we are seeing. The numbers have grown substantially over the last 2 years and it’s believed that this growth will continue with the outreach efforts of the Utah Mammoth. The two new sheets they built are certainly appreciated, but the growth we are seeing is outpacing the ability to grow ice offerings, so we are forced to improve utilization of the ice across the state.</p> <p>It was reiterated that there will be additional amendments made out of cycle, once the new USAH governance updates are released from the legislative meetings.</p> <p>The timeline for P and P amendments was reiterated again, with all submissions due through committee by 11 February (submitted to Secretary), then a compiled list will be posted publicly by the 15th</p> <p>With that, the summary of this discussion was submitted as public record, to be entered as minutes on the UAHA website.</p>
