SC Wildcats Parent's Code of Conduct

1. As an SC Wildcats parent, I will not force my child to participate in sports.
2. I agree to remember that my child is participating in the organization to have fun and that the game is for the child and not the adults.
3. I will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or others.
4. I will learn the rules of the game and the policies and procedures of the league.
5. I will always be a positive role model for my child and encourage good sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy and giving positive support to all players, coaches, officials, and spectators at every game, practice, and other league/chapter/team events.
6. I will not boo, taunt, refuse to shake hands, use profane language or gestures to any official, coach, parent, or player.
7. I will not encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health or well-being of the athletes.
8. I will teach my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
9. I will demand that my child treat other players, coaches, officials, and spectators with respect and dignity.
10. I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning and never feel defeated by the outcome of a game or by his/her performance; that competing fairly and trying hard is the name of the game.
11. I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participant for making a mistake or losing a competition.
12. I will emphasize skill development and practices and how they benefit my child over winning.
13. I will promote the emotional and physical well-being of the athletes ahead of any personal desire I may have for my child to win.
14. I will respect the officials and their authority during the games and will never question, discuss, or confront coaches on the game field but will speak with them at a designated time and place.
15. I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the official coaches of the team.
16. I will abide by all SCYSA and GCYFL rules and guidelines.

VIOLATION POLICY

First offense: Individual asked to leave the premises. Failure to do so will result in a second offense.

Second offense: Individual removed from the premises and suspended from participating for one week, along with their child (player/cheerleader).

Third offense: Parent & child (player/cheerleader) expelled from the chapter.
