GUIDELINES FOR 1971 CONVENTION AND ALL-SPORTS CLINIC

April 7 - 8, 1971, Jack Tar Hotel, San Francisco

REGISTRATION:

8:00-9:00 — Wednesday April 7th — Pacific Heights Room

Advance Registration may be accomplished by filling out the attached form at a **\$2.00 Savings. Deadline** for advance registration is March 20th.

FEES:

Membership — 1971 membership is required for admission to the clinic. If you are not a current member an \$8.00 fee will be required.

Advance Registration \$12.00 — (Save \$2.00) This includes your Banquet Ticket on Thursday.

Late Registration \$14.00 — This includes your Banquet Ticket on Thursday.

Tuition —(optional) \$16.00 for 2 **semester** units of credit for Physical Education 399.8 will be offered by the University of San Francisco. An evaluation paper meeting course requirements must be turned in in person after 3:00 p.m. Thursday, April 8th, before leaving the clinic.

Note: This is a **called** convention & clinic which means the Superintendent of Public Instruction has notified all districts in the State of California of the conference. If your district pays expenses to conferences this is an authorized conference.
