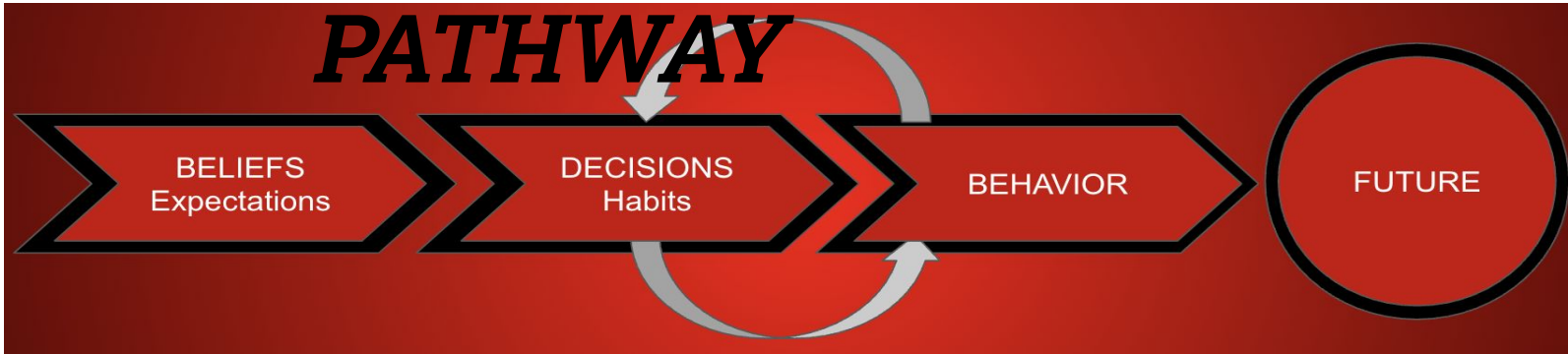

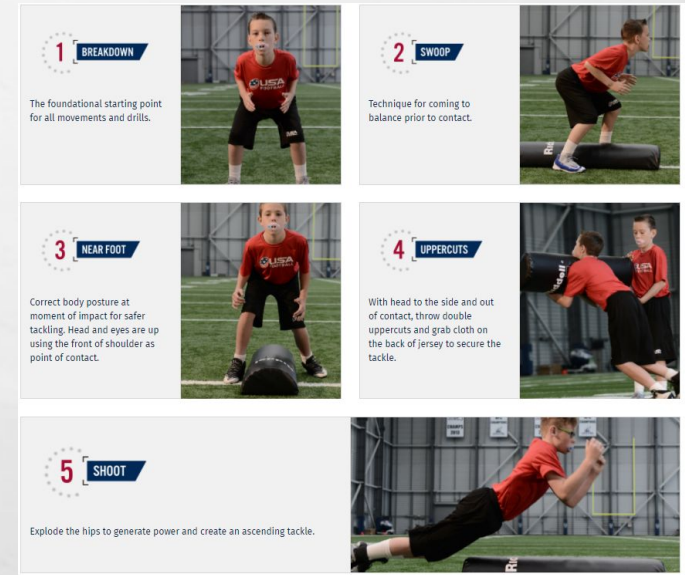
- Year-round development: Strength Building / Speed / Mobility

- Licensed Athletic Trainers on site at all football games
- Free access to Licensed Athletic Trainers is available during the season
- Season starts with conditioning period
 - Pre-season practices - 8 hours of shirts/shorts/cleats only
 - First 3 full practices are helmets only, then 2 practices helmets/shoulder pads

Schedule...what should I expect?

- Middle School football season is 4-5 days/week for 10 weeks.
- Games are on **Tuesdays**
- **Prior to school starting (August)** – practices will be in the evening – Mon-Thurs
4:30pm to 7:00pm, Fridays 3:30pm-6:00pm
 - Monday to Friday.
- **During the school year (Sept/Oct)** – practices are after school – 3:30 to 5:30pm

What does the Game Schedule look like?

- Games on Tuesdays.
- Game times sequenced by grade – 4:30pm, 5:45pm, 7:00pm
 - Away games - buses depart ~75 minutes prior to game time
- 1 game before the first day of school

How does team setup & rostering work?

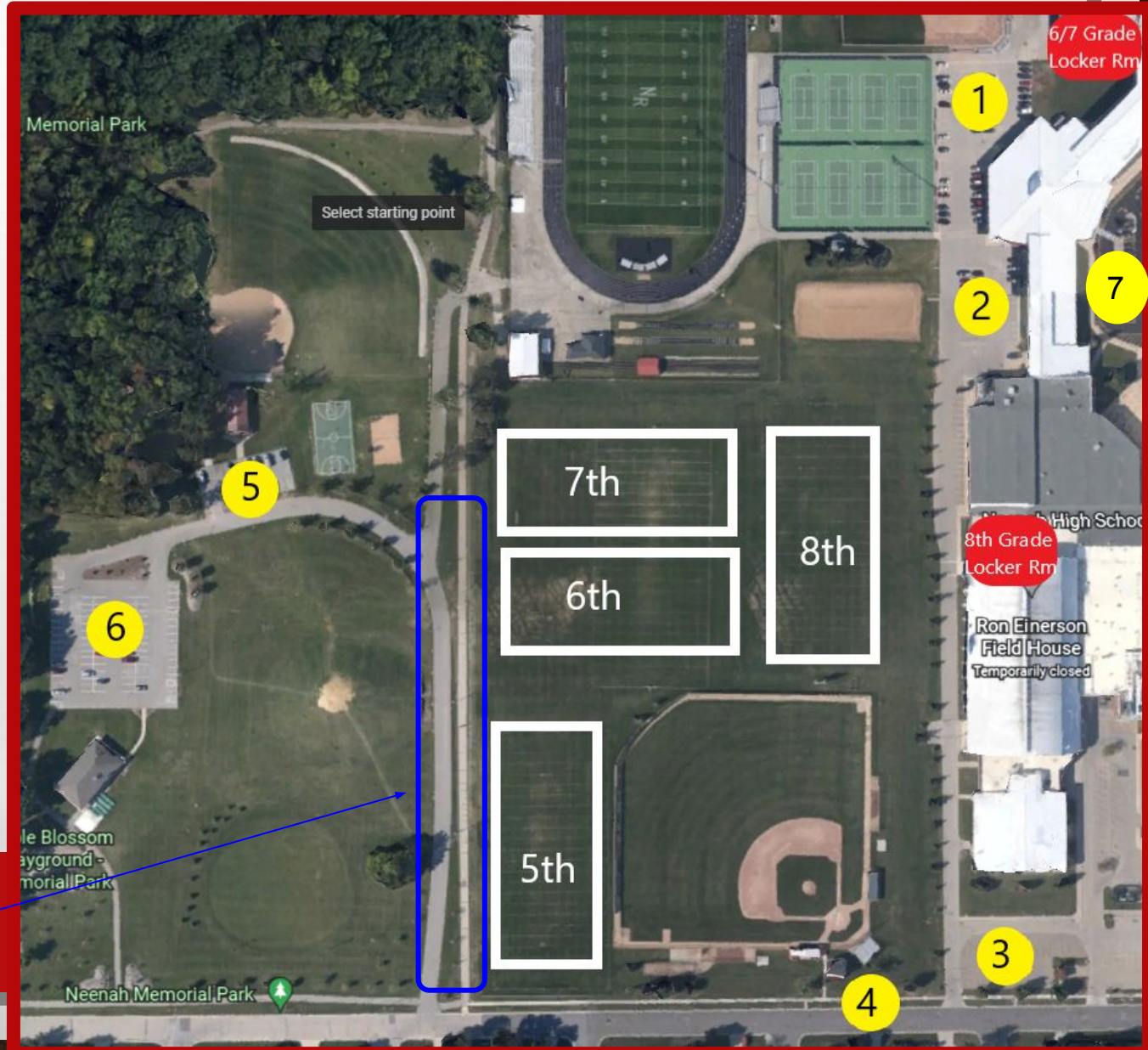

- Every grade has 2 teams – we call them “Red” and “White”
 - We are one program and truly one team. We are all Neenah Rockets!
 - However, since we typically have 60-70 kids play football in each grade – we create 2 teams to allow for more playing time in games for everyone.
- Rosters are created to have 2 equal, balanced teams.
 - Players do not automatically stay on the same color team year-to-year.
 - Example – if your player was on Red in 6th Grade, then they may get rostered to either Red or White in 7th Grade, as needed, to ensure we have equal, balanced teams every year.
 - Siblings in different grades are placed on the same color team with the older grade deciding.
 - Example, if your family has a 6th grader and a 7th grader – whatever color team the 7th grader is placed on, then the 6th grader will be placed on the same.
- The first week of practice in August is used to assess players for ability and potential positions, typically by the start of week 2 of practice your player will be informed which team they are on.
 - *This means you will not know your player’s specific game schedule until the 2nd week of practice.*

Neenah Middle School Football Map

- Practice Fields = white boxes
- Locker Rooms = red boxes
- Parking for Pick-Up = yellow circles
 - 7 - (front main parking lot)- option to avoid traffic for everyone.
 - 1 & 2 - first choice for 6th/7th grade
 - 3 & 4 - first choice for 8th grade
 - 5 & 6 - options to avoid the heavy traffic on backside of school

There are "No Parking" signs posted in this area. You risk receiving a parking citation if you park where prohibited.

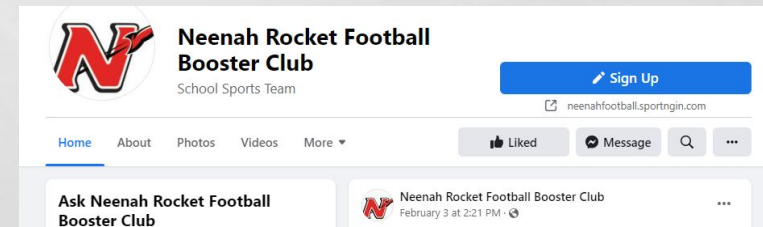

Academic Eligibility - NJSD

- If a student fails 2 classes during Spring Semester of 6th or 7th Grade, then they must sit out the first 2 football games the next Fall.
 - The student-athlete still practices with the team during the entire season. (Practice participation is not impacted, only the ability to play in games)
- This NJSD policy does not affect athletes playing in Fall of their 6th grade year
- Please note - this academic eligibility policy affects all sports participation (it is not specific to Football)

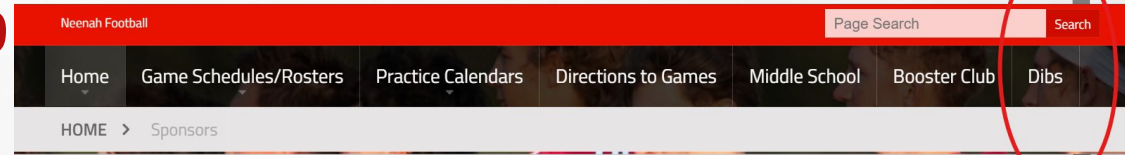




Physical Paperwork Submission to NJSD

- This can be confusing: for preparticipation physical evaluations, the "year" is from April 1st to March 31st
- Date ranges for this football season:
 - **Physical dated April 2026 or later** - submit the physical paperwork to Cami Czech after July 1st
 - **Physical dated April 2025 to March 2026** - then just submit Alternate Year card if you submitted Physical the prior year. (If never previously submitted the physical, then submit BOTH Physical paperwork and Alternate Year card)
 - **Physical dated March 2025 or earlier** - then need to get a new physical with doctor.
- If your athlete needs a medical physical - you can do it now! (anytime after April 1st each year)
 - Don't wait - get it done now so you aren't scrambling in July.

Volunteer Expectations



- **Every Family**

- Sign up to help with 2 items per athlete in the program. Sign up through Dibs.
- Extended family, friends of the family, and siblings (AGE 14 and OLDER) may sign up to fill the spot on behalf of the athlete.
- More communication will be communicated to parents as the season gets closer. The Quarterback Club will follow-up with parents who have not signed up mid-way through the season. You may be assigned a volunteer spot if you have not signed up by then.

- **Volunteer Opportunities**

1. **Chain Gang at your player's home games** (3 people per game)
 2. **High School Game Concession Stand** (Please do this if possible!)
 - Varsity, JV, and Freshman games available!
 3. **Concession stand at Neenah Middle School stadium games**

Assistant Coaches are critical

Football teams require a lot of coaches to run productive practices with many drills and position work.

There are a lot of players and a lot of positions. If we only have a few coaches per team - that limits how much each player can learn and develop.

- **"I cannot get away from work or other commitments for 5 days a week for 9 weeks"**
 - If you can only make it 2-3 days per week - that is okay! Any help you can provide is appreciated.
 - Don't let shift work or certain days with critical commitments stop you from helping on the days you are available.
 - We do need the head coaches there most every day.
- **"I cannot get away from work in time to be at practice at 3:30pm during the school year"**
 - Practice during the school year (Sept/Oct) runs 3:30 to 5:30. At least one coach does need to be there early to open the locker rooms, get things ready, and start the warm-up. If others can get there but will arrive later - this is just fine and understood.
 - If you can only make it for the 2nd hour - no worries - any help is greatly appreciated. (Same goes if you can only make the 1st hour)
- **"I am not a football expert; I cannot coach & teach how to play football"**
 - Do we need some coaches that know football well? Yes, of course.
 - But we don't need everyone to be the second coming of Vince Lombardi. There are plenty of things you can do to help run drills (don't worry - we will teach them to you, and partner you with other coaches).
