

Overview

In the TRAA October Board Meeting, John Masica highlighted a \$1,500 scholarship from MYAS for basketball and noted that repairs to the main equipment shed door would not occur until November 11. Tracy reported on volleyball, mentioning that 68 attendees participated in the informational meeting, with seven teams forming and tryouts scheduled for mid-November. Miquela Hernandez shared updates for basketball, indicating an increase in travel teams and the organization of a community tournament for MLK weekend, while addressing challenges faced in softball regarding coach shortages and field allocations. Adam provided insights on baseball progress and community engagement surrounding the Salvo soccer program, alongside discussions about the City of Mendota Heights' park master plan. Lacrosse updates revealed no significant changes, but potential community projects were proposed. Additionally, the Board confirmed action items for various members, including scheduling registrations, collecting auction items for the Friendly Hills Middle School silent auction, and addressing field work communications.
